The rates of reimbursement for the Child and Adult Care Food Program effective **July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016** are as follows:

(Expressed in whole or fractions of U.S. Dollars)

|                   | <u>Breakfasts</u> | <u>Lunches/Suppers</u> | <u>Supplements/Snacks</u> |
|-------------------|-------------------|------------------------|---------------------------|
| Free (A)          | 1.66              | 3.07                   | .84                       |
| Reduced-Price (B) | 1.36              | 2.67                   | .42                       |
| Paid (C)          | .29               | .29                    | .07                       |

**NOTE:** The above rates **do not** include the value of commodities or cash-in-lieu of commodities which centers can receive as additional assistance for each lunch or supper served to participants if you choose to receive cash rather than donated commodities. The value of commodities has been published in the Federal Register and established at **.2375 cents** per each lunch or supper meal.
