**PROCEDURE:**

Please update your current income eligibility guidelines and discard any outdated policy notice. Ensure that your Household Letter is revised to reflect the new income guidelines.

**POLICY:**

The center representative is to compare the adult participant's household income to the effective income eligibility guidelines and determine the appropriate reimbursement category; Free, Reduced-Price or Paid. The Income Eligibility Guidelines for the Child and Adult Care Food Program effective **July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017** are as follows:
