

FY 2017–FY 2019 State Plan on Aging

Public Hearings

Public hearings on the FY 2017–FY 2019 State Plan on Aging will be held in three locations in the state to allow for public comment. The State Plan on Aging is developed on a three-year planning cycle and will be submitted to the Administration on Aging by July 1, 2016. The State Plan on Aging details the Department's programs and initiatives for the three-year period.

The hearings will be held at the following locations:

- **May 16th at 1:00 p.m.** in Sycamore at **DeKalb County Community Foundation** (located at 475 DeKalb Avenue in the Freight Room).
- **May 19th at 10:00 a.m.** in Marion at **Marion Senior Center** (located at 507 West Main).
- **May 26th at 1:00 p.m.** in Springfield at the **Illinois Department of Agriculture** (located at 801 East Sangamon Avenue, Auditorium, State Fairground, Gate 11).

Members of the public can present comments on the FY 2017–FY 2019 State Plan on Aging in-person at the hearings or submit written comments by June 10th. If conducting oral testimony at the public hearings, please provide a copy of your testimony in writing.
