***Department on Aging is moving its Springfield offices***

**SPRINGFIELD** – Staff of the Illinois Department on Aging (IDoA) main office, which is located at 421 E. Capitol Avenue in Springfield, will relocate to the following address:

The move is scheduled to run December 3 through December 10, 2010. Director Charles D. Johnson sent notification to providers thanking them for patience and understanding during the relocation process, as well as for their ongoing dedication to serving older adults in Illinois.

Due to the move, the *Senior HelpLine* and *Circuit Breaker/Illinois Cares Rx* automated phone system will be inactive as of noon on Thursday, December 9. The automated phone system is scheduled to resume full function and accept calls at 8:30 a.m., on Monday, December 13.
