## **Half price Museum admission during March for residents of Knox, Mason and Tazewell Counties**

*SPRINGFIELD* – The Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum is continuing its popular “Community Days” promotion, with March 2011 featuring special half price admission for residents of Knox, Mason and Tazewell Counties.

During March 2011, adult residents of Knox, Mason and Tazewell Counties in Illinois may visit the Presidential Museum for half price. After presenting a valid ID showing their place of residence, adults from these counties will pay just \$6 each during the month to visit the nation’s most popular presidential museum. Admission prices for residents of other areas will remain the same - \$12 for adults; \$9 for students and senior citizens; \$7 for military; and \$6 for children under 15.

“Community Days offers our neighbors another reason to experience this treasure in their own back yards, whether they are first time or repeat visitors,” said Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum Director Eileen Mackevich.
