



CONTEST RULES

The purpose of the contest is to celebrate the life and legacy of Abraham Lincoln. This year's theme is "Lincoln in Illinois."

- Complete the above entry form in full, cut, and attach to the back of the poster entry.
- **DEADLINE:** All posters must be postmarked by **DECEMBER 18, 2015.**
- Categories are as follows: **Grades K-5, 6-8, and 9-12.**
- Artwork must be submitted without folding or bending. Required size: 11"W x 14"H on poster board and portrait orientation.
- Artwork may be done in crayon, ink, paint, colored pencil, or marking pens. Chalk, glitter, or laminated works will not be accepted. (If pencil, make sure it is dark enough to be reproduced.)
- Artwork must be original and two-dimensional. Cannot trace or copy existing Lincoln art.
- Do not use copyrighted characters (Batman, Shrek, Disney, etc.)
- Posters will be judged on connection to Abraham Lincoln, creativity and general design.
- Winning posters will be reproduced for display in the Museum.
- All posters become the property of the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum. See attached Photo/Video Release form. Requires parent/guardian signature.



Photo/Video Release
