How to Visit

“Undying Words” is presented in the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum. The exhibition is free with regular admission to the museum. Passes to the exhibition only – and not the rest of the museum – are available for \$5.

The museum is located in Springfield, Ill., at 212 N. Sixth Street. It is easily accessible from Interstate 55 and Interstate 72. It is also a short walk from Springfield’s Amtrak station.

The museum is open 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. every day. The only days it is closed are New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day.

The library, home to our vast collection of historic documents and artifacts, is open 9-5 Monday through Friday. It is closed on official state holidays. There is no charge for admission to the library.

The ALPLM parking garage is on the corner of Sixth and Madison streets, just northwest of the museum building. The rate is 75 cents per 1/2 hour or \$1.50 per hour. Hours: 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. daily.

The admission fee includes not just the main ALPLM but also a display of props and costumes from the Academy Award-winning movie “Lincoln.” The cost is:

Adult (16 - 61 years of age)	\$15.00
Senior (62 years of age and up)	\$12.00
Children (5 - 15 years of age)	\$6.00
Military (ID required)	\$10.00
Students (ID required)	\$12.00
Child (under 5 are free)	No Charge
