Brief Description

The Capital Development Board has declared an emergency at the Menard Correctional Center Minimum Security Unit in Chester, Illinois. An emergency affidavit was filed on July 12, 2011. A slope failure on the North side of the facility has caused damage to security lighting and the outer security fencing. Continued failure of the slope will endanger the buildings and compromise facility security.

Work is continuing at the site and currently waiting on excavation work to be complete near fence area to relocate fiber. This work will not be completed within the 90-day time period, which expires on October 11, 2011.

HEARING DISPOSITION


An Emergency Extension Public Hearing was held on October 11, 2011, to hear testimony and receive comments on extending the contracts for stabilizing the north slope that is failing at the Menard Correctional Center Minimum Security Unit in Chester Illinois. Attached is a list of the people who were present at the Hearing.

Bob Bauer, the Project Manager for CDB, answered questions about the project. SPO Bill Strahle asked the status of the project and when it was scheduled to be completed. Mr. Bauer said it was 40% completed and should be finished in 60 days, weather permitting. SPO Strahle asked Mr. Bauer if 90 days would work better and take weather concerns out of the schedule. Mr. Bauer said it would.

Mr. Bauer did comment that the seeding of the slope might have to wait until the spring. But that he had to discuss this with the Architect/Engineering firm on the project. SPO Strahle asked Mr. Bauer approximately how much the seeding would cost and he said \$3,400. Mr. Bauer went on to say that if the seeding was to wait until next Spring, then he would do a deduct change order for the work.

No other persons offered testimony or comments on this project.

SPO Strahle recommended an extension of 90 days in order to complete the work on this project.
