The registered lobbyist is JAR Consulting, Inc. Individual lobbyists are James A. Riemer Sr. and James A. Riemer, Jr. Mr. Riemer Sr. was employed at the Capital Development Board as its executive director until December 31, 2010.

The Procurement Policy Board reviewed this matter at its June 14, 2011 meeting. The Board voted to recommend that the selection be voided. In accordance with Section 50-35 of the Illinois Procurement Code, the Chief Procurement Officer must hold a public hearing if the selection is to result in an award of a contract.

You are requested to present any information that may be pertinent to this matter or which may help in the determination of whether a conflict of interest exists, including your role in the selection process or knowledge of involvement of a registered lobbyist in the selection process.
