In Fall 2008, Truman College began construction on the \$55 million Larry McKeon Administrative Building, funded by the State of Illinois and the City of Chicago. The project is expected to be complete by Fall 2010. The new building will allow the college to consolidate all Student Service functions into one location. In turn, this will permit the existing building to accommodate additional classroom space. The parking deck will provide more than 1,100 spaces.

The facility is expected to be certified as LEED Silver and will include:

Water Efficient Landscaping

Water Use Reduction through Low-Flow Fixtures

Cool Roof

Divert 75% of Construction Waste from Landfills

20% of Materials Purchased will be Local/Regional Materials

Low VOC in Paint, Carpet, Adhesives & Sealants, Composite
