The Directory of Illinois Building Related Requirements, (Directory), is a compilation of the numerous state building requirements governing building construction within the State of Illinois.

The Directory is intended to be a comprehensive reference source for State building requirements. However, as new laws are passed, and as State agencies, Boards and Commissions propose new and amendatory regulations, additions or revisions may occur. This Directory is only as current as the information available on the date of its publication.

Each subject area of this Directory includes regulatory information provided by the referenced State agency of the applicable laws, promulgated rule(s), as well as, a summary statement of the requirements and information to assist users in contacting the appropriate agency representatives.

The laws of the State of Illinois are codified in a format referenced as the "Illinois Compiled Statutes" ("ILCS"). The Illinois Administrative Code ("IAC") contains the regulatory programmatic interpretation of statutes for all State agencies. Reference copies of the Compiled Statutes and the Illinois Administrative Code are available at most local libraries or by visiting www.ilga.gov

The *Illinois Register* is the official State publication through which the public is informed of all rulemaking activity. The *Illinois Register* is published weekly and contains the First Notice publication of rulemaking proposals, actions by the Joint Committee on Administrative Rules (JCAR), notices of final adoption of rulemakings, Regulatory Agendas (January/July), Executive Orders and Proclamations, and indexes to the current and previous issues. Copies of the *Illinois Register* are available from the Index Department of the Office of the Secretary of State and most local libraries.

No attempt is made by the Capital Development Board, Division of Building Codes & Regulations to provide a legal interpretation of the laws, administrative regulations or programs identified within this Directory. The CDB recommends that independent legal counsel be contacted for legal-based interpretations. More appropriately, that the agencies referenced be contacted regarding administrative rules of interest. The identified agencies for each subject area are the authorities for their individual referenced programs. The intent is to assist interested parties in obtaining information from those Illinois State agencies involved in state construction.

Note: Prior to any design or construction activity, a clear understanding of local jurisdiction requirements is the responsibility of all entities involved.
