We are again pleased to report on the state's School Construction Program, Which has now assisted 420 school districts throughout Illinois in creating better learning environments for the school children of this state.

Jointly administered by the Illinois Capital Development Board and the Illinois State Board of Education, the school construction program was created by the General Assembly in December 1997. Since then, the state has awarded more than \$2.7 billion in state-funded grants to help local school districts replace aging classrooms and construct additional classrooms to ease overcrowding. The School Construction Program has been successful as a state-local partnership, using state and local funds to create 14,239 new classrooms in 275 new schools and 2,924 renovations and additions throughout Illinois.

We look forward to continuing the state-local partnership to improve even more schools for students in the State of Illinois.

Program Overview

What is the State of Illinois School Construction Program? The School Construction Law (Public Act 90-548) was passed by the Illinois General Assembly in December 1997. It established the School Construction Program and authorized \$1.4 billion in state support for school construction in public schools. Through Governor George H. Ryan's Illinois FIRST program, \$1.1 billion was provided, the Illinois General Assembly authorized an additional \$930 million in FY2003 to assist districts in every area of the state. The emphasis of the program is on projects that alleviate the shortage of classroom space due to population growth or aged buildings.

Who is eligible?

School Districts must be able to document local share Matching contribution prior to grant award. School Districts must meet the minimum enrollment requirements:

- Elementary districts with 200 students minimum enrollment.
- High school districts with 200 students minimum enrollment.
- Unit districts with 400 students minimum enrollment

What revenues are available?

State Funds:

- School Construction Law authorizes \$1.4 billion
- Illinois First authorizes \$1.1 billion
- FY2003 the General Assembly authorizes \$930 million

Local Funding Options:

- Alternate Revenue Bonds
- Fund Balances
- General Revenue Bonds
- Health/Life Safety
- Home Rule Sales Tax Contribution
- Maintenance and Operations Revenue


What are the construction grant priorities?

School districts can apply for projects in these categories:

- A** Natural or man-made disasters
- B** Classroom shortage due to population growth and/or building age
- C** Interdistrict reorganization
- D** Severe and continuing Health/Life Safety Hazards
- E** Alterations necessary to provide accessibility for Qualified individuals with disabilities
- F** Other unique solutions

How can school districts apply?

School Districts should assess the facility needs and complete the *Application for Construction Grant Entitlement*, available from ISBE or CDB. Coordinating the timing of submitting an application, receiving entitlement and holding a referendum are critical to ensure eligibility of the application. School Districts are encouraged to submit an application at least two months prior to the date of the referendum, if it is required.






