Target Title: **Psychologist II**
Position Title Code: 35612
Salary Grade: RC-063-20
Credential or Certificate: Credential

This position is located in Mental Health, Corrections, and Rehabilitation Services facilities in counties throughout the state.

Note: The majority of the Psychologist positions are at the Psychologist II level.

A Psychologist II, under general supervision, regularly provides intensive psychotherapy and in-depth counseling to the mentally ill, the developmentally disabled and other disabled persons; regularly designs and implements behavioral modification programs; serves as a resource to less experienced psychologists and psychology graduate students and other professionals; assists more experienced psychologists in providing training to psychology students in psychodiagnostics and other areas of psychology.

This title is distinguished by regularly exercising responsibility for selecting and administering therapeutic and research techniques for recipients exhibiting a broad range of disorders.

Minimum Training and Experience

1) Possession of a doctoral degree in psychology plus one year of professional experience in psychology; OR 2) Possession of a Master's degree in psychology plus four years of professional experience in psychology.

NOTE: Experience cannot be substituted in lieu of the Master's degree in psychology. A graduate degree in a field other than psychology is acceptable only if the candidate is currently licensed in Illinois as a Psychologist.

Meeting the requirements listed on this annotated guide will entitle participants to be evaluated as QUALIFIED which is equal to a "B" grade.

Exceeding the minimum requirements by at least one year of full-time related experience, or related college, will generally entitle the participant to be evaluated with an "A" grade.
