IDNR has led the rebranding of invasive carp to combat public misconceptions about the fish and increase consumer interest in this healthful, delicious, top-feeding protein source – all with the intent of helping a new industry become established. The Copi® brand launched in June 2022, generating regional, national and international attention. Illinois processors have reported significant increases in sales since the launch, and nationwide online sales are now available.

"We're delighted to host Chef Maurice and his elevated take on Copi® in Conservation World this year," **said IDNR Director Natalie Phelps Finnie**. "There continues to be a lot of curiosity about the fish and how to cook with it, and we're looking forward to fairgoers having a chance to learn how light, delicious and versatile it is."
