In accordance with the requirements of Section 50-35 of the Illinois Procurement Code, I have reviewed your request received December 3, 2012 and understand the facts to be as follows:


1. The Illinois Capital Development Board has issued a request for a review and comment on potential conflicts of interest disclosed by Laverdiere Construction, Inc.
2. The contract pertains to the replacement of damaged support steel at the Power House located at the Quincy Illinois Veterans' Home.
3. Laverdiere Construction, Inc. was selected using Small Purchase.
4. The disclosure form submitted on behalf of Laverdiere Construction, Inc. indicates the following:
 - a. Nancy Laverdiere, spouse, Western Illinois University, Web Specialist II (Library Assistant) in Malpass Library, start date 2/23/1998, she does not earn more than \$106,447.20 annually, she is wife of Jack Laverdiere (president and sole director of Laverdiere Construction Inc).
5. Illinois Capital Development Board confirmed that none of the disclosed individuals were in a position to influence the award of this contract. Illinois Capital Development Board and CPO Fred Hahn indicate that it would be in the best interest of the State to approve this conflict of interest due to the using agency's needs and the value of the contract.

Based on the foregoing, you are requesting my review and comment pursuant to the Illinois Procurement Code.

Review and Comment

After careful review of the documentation provided, I do not view the relationships disclosed above as creating a conflict of interest sufficient to preclude Illinois Capital Development Board from entering into a contract with Laverdiere Construction, Inc. for the services outlined in your letter received December 3, 2012.
