Dear Mr. Hahn,

In accordance with the requirements of Section 50-35 of the Illinois Procurement Code, I have reviewed your request received April 27, 2015 and understand the facts to be as follows:

- 1) The Capital Development Board has issued a request for a review and comment on potential conflicts of interest disclosed by VEYA, Inc., subcontractor of Grunloh Construction Company.
- 2) The contract pertains to construction related services.
- 3) VEYA, Inc. was selected via contractor-subcontractor agreement.
- 4) The disclosure form submitted on behalf of VEYA, Inc. indicates the following:
 - a. Maria Thompson, spouse of VEYA, Inc. 100% owner Patrick Thompson, is employed by UIUC as a Purchasing Manager in Facilities and Services at a salary of \$66,291.75. Patrick Thompson has a 100% ownership interest in the vendor.
- 5) The Capital Development Board confirmed that none of the disclosed individuals were in a position to influence the award of this contract. The Capital Development Board and CPO Hahn indicate that it would be in the best interest of the State to approve this conflict of interest due to the using agency's needs and the value of the contract.

Based on the foregoing, you are requesting my review and comment pursuant to the Illinois Procurement Code.

Review and Comment

After careful review of the documentation provided, I do not view the relationships disclosed above as creating a conflict of interest sufficient to preclude Grunloh Construction Company from entering into a subcontract with VEYA, Inc. for the services outlined in your letter received April 27, 2015.
