Dear Ms. Lawton,

In accordance with the requirements of Section 50-35 of the Illinois Procurement Code, I have reviewed your request received July 8, 2015 and understand the facts to be as follows:

- 1) The Capital Development Board has issued a request for a review and comment on potential conflicts of interest disclosed by Perry Broughton Trucking & Excavating, Inc., subcontractor of P.H. Broughton & Sons.
- 2) The contract pertains to construction related services.
- 3) The subcontractor was selected via contractor-subcontractor agreement.
- 4) The disclosure form submitted on behalf of the subcontractor indicates the following:
 - a. Sarah E. Shike, daughter of Rachel A. Broughton, 51% owner, and William Perry Broughton, 49% owner, is a part-time Adjunct Professor, College of Business at Western Illinois University. Her annual salary is \$44,000.
- 5) The Capital Development Board confirmed that none of the disclosed individuals were in a position to influence the award of this contract. The Capital Development Board and CPO Hahn indicate that it would be in the best interest of the State to approve this conflict of interest due to the using agency's needs and the value of the contract.

Based on the foregoing, you are requesting my review and comment pursuant to the Illinois Procurement Code.

Review and Comment

After careful review of the documentation provided, I do not view the relationships disclosed above as creating a conflict of interest sufficient to preclude the above-named prime vendor from entering into a subcontract with the above-named subcontractor.
