Brief Descriptions: The Office of the Chief Procurement Officer for the Capital Development Board will hold a public hearing to hear testimony and receive comments on the proposed extension of the emergency procurement for design and construction services from Hurst-Rosche, Inc. and Lake Contracting, Inc. which are providing emergency structural steel replacements for the Murray Development Center coal bunker conveyor system located in Centralia, Il.

HEARING DISPOSITION

A Public Hearing was held on February 2, 2016, to hear testimony and receive comments on extending the procurements for design services from Hurst-Rosche, Inc. and construction services from Lake Contracting, Inc. which are providing emergency structural steel replacements for the Murray Development Center coal bunker conveyor system located in Centralia, IL. A recording of the hearing is available and will be published online.

Robert Bauer, CDB Project Manager, provided a brief history and current status of the project. A Pre-Construction meeting was held on January 17, 2016. CDB received the construction schedule from Lake Contracting, Inc. which reflected 10 days to prepare shop drawings and detailing. Steel fabrication timeline will be 18 days, with 12 days to galvanize the steel. Installation of the new steel should take 40 days. Their schedule indicates a completion date of June 30, 2016. Since the work must be performed while the coal bunker remains operational, as a precaution, an additional 60 days for project close-out for the contractor and an additional 90 day extension for the A/E's contract was requested to avoid the need for additional time extensions. However, it is not anticipated the construction schedule will exhaust the established timelines. All scopes of work discussed in the request for extension of the emergency procurement have been factored into the existing contract quotes.

There are no foreseeable risks to completing the project as currently scheduled, but again as a precautionary measure extending the contract end dates for both vendors is warranted.

All attendees were asked if they had any comments. No other persons offered testimony or comments on this project.

Hearing Officer Gerald Burlingham recommends extending Lake Contracting, Inc.'s contract until August 31, 2016 and extending Hurst-Rosche, Inc.'s contract until October 30, 2016 to allow ample time for final billing documents and drawings to be submitted on this project.

I concur with the recommendation to extend this emergency procurement.
