Subject: Small Purchase Thresholds-FY 2016 CPI Adjustment

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This CPO Notice is effective July 1, 2015 and supersedes CPO Notice 2014.02.

This notice is issued pursuant to Section 20-20(b) of the Illinois Procurement Code to show the Consumer Price Index (CPI) adjustment to certain small purchase thresholds. Under Section 20-20 of the Code, small purchases may be made without competitive sealed bidding.

The CPI percentage being used to make the adjustment is 0.8%. The percentage change was determined by utilizing statistics published by the United States Department of Labor Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers.

Effective July 1, 2015, the small purchase thresholds for procurements under the authority of the CPO for General Services will be as follows:

- Supplies and Services: not exceeding \$50,400 (This is an increase from the FY 15 amount calculated as \$50,000 + .8% rounded to the nearest \$100).
- Construction: not exceeding \$70,600 (This is an increase from the FY 15 amount calculated as \$70,000 + .8% to the nearest \$100).
- Professional and Artistic Services: less than \$20,000 (This amount is not subject to change. See 30 ILCS 500/35-35.)
