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ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOR A GROWING ECONOMY (EDGE) TAX CREDIT PROGRAM CALENDAR YEAR 2012 REPORT

One of the most successful economic development tools provided by the General Assembly and Governor Pat Quinn is the Economic Development for a Growing Economy (EDGE) Tax Credit Program.

The EDGE Tax Credit Program is a targeted tax incentive program that provides tax credits for businesses that create new full-time jobs, retain existing full-time jobs and make capital investments in Illinois. The EDGE Tax Credit Program is designed to help areas of Illinois that are in direct competition with other states for jobs and development.

The following report identifies the guidelines and accomplishments of the EDGE Tax Credit Program.

EDGE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The Illinois Economic Development for a Growing Economy (EDGE) Tax Credit Program is intended to help the state compete with other states for the location of job creation or retention projects.

The Illinois EDGE Tax Credit Program is operated by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. Based on a review of a written application submitted by an interested firm, the Department is authorized to designate qualified businesses as “eligible”. Eligible businesses may claim a nonrefundable tax credit against their state income taxes. (The amount of the tax credit is calculated based on the income taxes paid by new employees and the retained employees.)

The designation is contingent upon the business undertaking a development project that:

- Involves at least \$5 million investment in capital improvements placed in service in Illinois and employs at least 25 New Full-Time Employees within the state as a direct result of the project; or
- Involves at least a \$2.5 million investment in capital improvements placed in service in Illinois and employs at least 50 New Full-Time Employees as a direct result of the project; or
- Involves an investment in a sufficient amount to employ at least 25 New Full-Time Employees, provided the project is located within or serves a distressed area or hires low-income workers; or
- Involves an investment at a level specified by the Department in capital improvements to be placed in service; employs New Full-Time Employees within the state at a level specified by the Department; and provides substantial economic benefit to the state, as determined by the Department. The Director may approve projects that do not meet the minimum job creation and investment thresholds for an applicant meeting all other requirements in the Act, providing that one or more of the following conditions are met:
 - A) The applicant’s business is located in a distressed community with an unemployment rate which is higher than the state’s average; or
 - B) The applicant’s business is located in an area with limited economic development prospects as evidenced by prior and current development activities; or
 - C) Approval would support a business with potential to generate additional growth in the area and create jobs as a result of spin-off businesses; or
 - D) Approval would avert the loss of one of the area’s major sources of employment.
- Involves a company with 100 or fewer Full-Time Employees whose investment will be at least \$1,000,000 in capital improvements which will be placed in service at a designated site in Illinois and employ at least 5 New Full-Time Employees at a designated site as a direct result of the project.

COMPETITORS' TAX CREDIT PROGRAMS

Illinois' primary competitors for business locations and expansions are the bordering states of Kentucky, Indiana, Iowa, Missouri and Wisconsin. These states have similarly adopted tax credits as incentives for businesses locating or expanding operations. Those programs most similar to the EDGE Tax Credit Program in neighboring states are:

- Economic Development for a Growing Economy (EDGE) – Indiana
- IA Industrial New Jobs Training Act – Iowa
- Kentucky Rural Economic Development Act (KREDA) – Kentucky

Table I below shows the similarities of the programs and highlights the advantage of the Illinois EDGE Tax Credit Program:

The Table illustrates that the EDGE Tax Credit Program is competitive with those of bordering states. Other competing states in which Illinois was chosen as the final project site include the following: Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Kansas, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Nebraska, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia and Wisconsin.

DESCRIPTION OF EDGE PROJECTS

The following is a description of each project, which was approved in Calendar Year 2012, which began on January 1, 2012 and ended on December 31, 2012.

EDGE PROJECT INFORMATION

Ace Hardware Corporation

The Company will extend its lease for and improve its existing Corporate Headquarters leased office buildings, including updating internal and external tenant improvements and configuration of the office space. The Company chose Illinois over a potential site in the Indianapolis, Indiana area.

The Company will retain 740 existing full-time jobs in connection with the Project. The Company will make Capital Improvements of \$28,289,158.

Acme Industries, Inc.

Acme Industries, Inc. needs to expand its production capacity by investing in new machinery and hiring additional skilled manufacturing employees. As part of the Company's strategic planning, they were evaluating whether a return on investment in Indiana at the time would be greater than further re-investment in Illinois, but decided on Illinois.

Acme Industries, Inc. will create 25 full-time jobs. The Company will retain 175 full-time jobs. Acme Industries, Inc. will make a Capital Investment of \$5,000,000.

ADP Dealer Services, Inc.

ADP Dealer Services, a division of ADP, Inc., is the leading provider of integrated computing solutions to truck, auto, motorcycle, marine, recreational vehicle & heavy equipment dealers worldwide; and is represented in nearly 100 countries worldwide. These computing solutions enable Dealer Services' clients to eliminate manual processes and streamline their business. The Company chose to expand its operations in Hoffman Estates, Illinois over Austin, Texas.

ADP Dealer Services will create 70 full-time jobs, retain 32 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$14,000,000.

Advantage Futures LLC

Advantage Futures LLC's headquarter lease expired in April, 2013. A more cost effective headquarter was required as the profitability of the futures brokerage business has decreased dramatically in recent years due primarily to the declining interest rate environment. The search for reduced costs has led the management to seek an alternative to the expensive Chicago real estate marketplace.

Advantage Futures LLC will relocate to a less expensive site in Chicago, Illinois over Dallas, Texas. Advantage Futures LLC will create 10 full-time jobs, retain 70 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$9,319,361.

Aisin Electronics Illinois, LLC #2

Due to the strength in the automotive market, Aisin Electronics Illinois, LLC in Marion, Illinois will expand its operation which includes a 79,000 square foot building expansion and equipment to produce various sensors for the automotive electronics market.

Aisin Electronics Illinois, LLC will create 80 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$32,810,000.

Akorn, Inc.

Akorn, Inc. is seeking an EDGE tax credit to retain manufacturing, R&D and back office functions in Illinois. Four locations are included in this project: 1) R&D facility in Skokie. Rapid growth has led to the needed expansion of the R&D facility, which is proposed to move from Skokie to Vernon Hills, where appropriate, available lab space has been identified, 2) manufacturing facility in Decatur, 3) packaging, warehousing and distribution facility in Decatur, and 4) headquarters in Lake Forest. The project includes the creation of 5 full-time R&D jobs in Vernon Hills, 5 full-time headquarters jobs in Lake Forest, and retention of 339 full-time jobs (287 full-time jobs in Decatur, Illinois, 30 full-time jobs in Lake Forest, Illinois and 22 full-time jobs in Vernon Hills, Illinois). This project does not include 54 employees at the Lake Forest headquarters that are not at risk of leaving Illinois.

The Company has recently acquired certain assets of Kilich Drugs (India) Limited which had led company leadership to consider the cost advantages of relocating the manufacturing operations currently performed in Decatur to its new owned campus in India, as well as, relocating its R&D activities to new space closer to the manufacturing facility. Also under exploration was the optimal location of certain non-managerial back-office functions currently at the Lake Forest headquarters. Back office functions could also be performed at existing, owned space in India.

Akorn, Inc. will make a Capital Investment of \$6,012,428.

American NTN Bearing Mfg. Corp.

Due to increased demand in Gen III hub bearings, American NTN Bearing Mfg. Corp. needs to install new lines and expand its existing building in Illinois. The Company will add an additional 70,000 square feet of space to this site to accommodate a new line of business. This business will serve the Company's suppliers namely Ford, Honda and Nissan.

The Company will create 150 full-time jobs (above their current baseline of 560 full-time jobs), of which 10 created full-time jobs will be at the 1500 Holmes Road, Elgin facility and 140 created full-time jobs will be at the 1700 Holmes Road, Elgin facility. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$53,000,000.

Amex Nooter, LLC

Amex Nooter, LLC is considered the consolidation of their Illinois and Indiana professional offices (management and clerical) to better serve customers in both the Illinois and Indiana markets. The current Illinois location at 16720 New Lenox Road, Joliet, Illinois 60433, cannot support the addition of the new employees. With a growing customer base in the Chicagoland and Northwest Indiana region, the Company has found that maintaining two separate offices has decreased its staff's ability to team and maximize efficiencies. The Company elected to consolidate its offices in Tinley Park.

Amex Nooter, LLC will create 14 full-time jobs, retain 11 full-time jobs, and make a Capital Investment of \$1,683,390.

Anixter, Inc. #2

Anixter Inc.'s project would add a second headquarters building at its current headquarters location in Glenview, Illinois, to expand regional and corporate support functions.

Anixter Inc. will create 66 full-time jobs, retain 60 full-time jobs (moving from Morton Grove), and make a Capital Investment of \$10,401,152.

Aux Sable Liquid Products, LP, and Affiliate Companies

Aux Sable Liquid Products, LP and affiliate companies will expand in Morris, Illinois over Palermo, North Dakota. The project will create 25 full-time jobs, above the Company's current baseline of 154 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$10,000,000.

Bell Sports, Inc.

Bell Sports, Inc. will make a substantial investment in constructing a state of the art Light Assembly and Distribution facility in Rantoul, Illinois instead of Dallas, Texas. Bell Sports, Inc. currently operates 5 buildings in Rantoul, but will consolidate these operations into a single facility.

Bell Sports, Inc. will create 50 full-time jobs, retain 255 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$44,120,811.

Belvedere Trading LLC

Belvedere Trading LLC is currently in a short term sublease situation and needs office space to accommodate its long term growth and business needs. The Company extensively utilizes technology and needs to make significant investments in an office that will not only cater to growing space requirements but also to their growing infrastructure needs, including redundant power sources, high speed telecommunications lines, and supplemental cooling. Belvedere Trading LLC was considering expanding its operations in Houston, Texas, because of the access to workforce and lower cost of real estate. However, the Company ultimately chose Illinois.

Belvedere Trading LLC will create 40 full-time jobs (above their current baseline of 151 full-time jobs), retain 50 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,862,216.

Bradley Services, Inc.

The project location is 231 Detroit Avenue in Morton, Illinois. This site replaces a facility at 935 Detroit Avenue in Morton, Illinois lost to a fire in March of 2012. Bradley Services, Inc.'s manufacturing operations are currently running out of a leased facility in Mapleton, Illinois. The facility at 935 Detroit was approximately 75,000 square feet and proposed facility will be approximately 150,000 square feet.

The Company will create 25 full-time jobs, retain 175 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$10,100,000.

Capital One Financial Corporation and Affiliates

As a result of the acquisition of HSBC's Credit Card assets, Capital One Financial Corporation and Affiliates needed to make major decisions about where to locate its marketing, information technology and servicing/call center functions. Some current HSBC positions must be relocated per the acquisition agreement, therefore certain jobs could be relocated to other existing facilities already owned and occupied by Capital One in order to take advantage of operating and cost efficiencies. Upon the closing of the HSBC Credit Card portfolio acquisition, Capital One Financial Corporation and Affiliates will create 120 full-time jobs, above the baseline of 980 full-time jobs, retain 900 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$35,760,305.

CareFusion Corporation

Since CareFusion Corporation's spin off from Cardinal Health, the Company has become a leader in the medical products and services industry. As part of improving CareFusion's competitive advantage and strengthening its corporate identity, the new management team is interested in establishing two Centers of Excellence in the United States. CareFusion plans to create a Center of Excellence for Medical Systems to serve the West Coast, and another Center of Excellence for Procedural Solutions in the Midwest to serve the Midwest and East Coast regions. CareFusion will create the Midwest Center of Excellence, in part, by relocating its current Waukegan, Illinois operations, to another location in Illinois over a site in Wisconsin. In addition to the two Centers of Excellence, CareFusion will maintain its manufacturing facilities across the country, including current Midwest facilities located in Middleton, Wisconsin and Plymouth, Minnesota.

CareFusion Corporation will create 75 full-time jobs, retain 250 existing full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$25,480,261.

Carl Buddig and Company #2

Carl Buddig and Company has an existing 210,000 square foot manufacturing facility in South Holland, Illinois. The Company processes, packages, stores and ships meat products from that facility and is currently the largest employer in South Holland. In 2012, Carl Buddig and Company

was awarded the production rights for a new product developed by one of the Company's largest customers. In order to accommodate this additional production, Carl Buddig and Company must currently add additional production equipment.

Carl Buddig and Company will create 25 full-time jobs above their current baseline of 728 full-time jobs. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$4,000,000.

Carlisle SynTec Inc. #2

Carlisle SynTec Incorporated will add a new roofing product line to its manufacturing capabilities. The Company had to decide whether to bring the new product line to its Greenville, Illinois facility or its Pennsylvania facility. The Company decided on Greenville.

The project will create 25 full-time jobs above their current 261 existing full-time jobs currently at the facility. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$25,000,000.

Catamaran Inc. f/k/a SXC Health Solutions, Inc.

With consistent substantial growth that Catamaran Inc. f/k/a SXC Health Solutions, Inc. is experiencing, the Company needed a new global headquarters location. Catamaran, Inc. recently leased a large facility in Phoenix, Arizona and contemplated either moving these jobs to Arizona and growing more there or moving out of its current headquarters space in Lisle, Illinois and relocating to Schaumburg, Illinois. The Company chose Schaumburg, Illinois.

Catamaran Inc. will create 200 full-time jobs, retain 250 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$40,899,266.

Cedar Concepts Corporation

Cedar Concepts Corporation is in need of a new manufacturing facility in order to increase the Company's production of surfactants, lubricants, and chemical intermediates. The Company is currently located in Chicago, Illinois. The Company also considered alternative sites in Gary and Hammond, Indiana. The Company will create 5 new full-time jobs and retain 26 existing full-time jobs at the new location, 4108-4134 South Packers Avenue, Chicago, Illinois. The Company's Capital Investment will be \$8,877,330.

CGB Diversified Services, Inc.

CGB Diversified Services, Inc.'s (CGBDS) current headquarters building in Jacksonville, Illinois is at maximum capacity. With estimated growth projections for the company in the upcoming years, CGBDS made a determination to expand at the facility in Jacksonville, Illinois over expanding at its new regional headquarters facility in Clarksdale, Mississippi.

CGB Diversified Services, Inc. will create 25 full-time jobs, retain 45 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$1,350,000.

Cheese Merchants of America, LLC

Cheese Merchants of America, LLC is currently located in Carol Stream, Illinois. The Company leases 87,000 square feet and employs 97 full-time people. A new facility is required in order to remain efficient and competitive. The Company identified 120,000 square feet of vacant space in Bartlett, Illinois for its new, expanded facility.

The Company will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 97 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$9,094,497.

Comtrak Logistics, Inc.

Hub Group, Inc. (parent company), needs a new corporate headquarters location for itself and its Subsidiaries. Hub Group, Inc. will acquire an approximately 17-acre site located in Oak Brook, Illinois. Hub Group, Inc. then intends to construct a new, approximately 120,000 square foot building on the site. Comtrak Logistics, Inc. will lease a portion of the new building from its parent company. Comtrak Logistics, Inc.'s employees are currently located in Downers Grove and McCook, Illinois.

Comtrak Logistics, Inc. will create 12 full-time jobs, retain 25 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,152,799.

Curtis Metal Finishing Company

Curtis Metal Finishing Company currently has an approximately 94,000 square foot facility in Machesney Park, Illinois. The Company will add approximately 27,300 square feet of plant facility, as well as, invest in new equipment in order to add to its processing capacity. Curtis Metal Finishing Company currently has a facility in Michigan which could accommodate an expansion, but chose the Illinois site.

Curtis Metal Finishing Company will create 14 full-time jobs, retain 55 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,064,000.

Custom Personalization Solutions, LLC

Custom Personalization Solutions, LLC (CPS), a start-up company, will act as a holding company to bring together two existing businesses (MBM and Brand-Xpand) and create a new to-be-formed specialty personalization business tentatively titled Personalized Planet. CPS will relocate its Brand-Xpand division that is based in Chattanooga, Tennessee and the new personalization division into production and office facilities in Bolingbrook, Illinois. Its MBM/Limoges Jewelry division will remain at the current Chicago, Illinois location.

Custom Personalization Solutions, LLC will create 67 full-time jobs in Bolingbrook, Illinois and retain 81 full-time jobs at their facility in Chicago, Illinois. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$3,793,719 at their new Bolingbrook facility.

D & W Fine Pack Holdings LLC

D & W Fine Pack Holdings LLC is integrating operations as the result of recent mergers, determining corporate executive roles and exploring sites for its worldwide corporate headquarters. The Company will relocate its headquarters from South Carolina to Illinois to take advantage of product development efficiencies, more talented job pool, and centralized location to other company sites.

D & W Fine Pack Holdings LLC will create 10 full-time jobs above the Company's current baseline of 141 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$1,100,000.

Data Group (US) Corp.

Data Group (US) Corp. will lease a 20,000 square foot facility in Niles, Illinois. The building will consist of office space, production and warehouse space. The new facility will help Data Group (US) Corp. to better serve its client's document management requirements. The Company will create 25 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,375,739.

Deere & Company & Subsidiaries #5

Deere & Company through its subsidiary, John Deere Shared Services, Inc., is in need of additional office space and needs to find a new site to relocate 75 office employees currently located at two Illinois Quad Cities locations. ATI Products, Inc., also a subsidiary of Deere & Company is also in need of additional warehouse space that will be used to store and distribute all makes of agricultural parts to independent John Deere dealers throughout the United States. After looking at viable sites in both Illinois and Iowa, a location in Rock Island has been identified that satisfies both of their needs. Warehouse space not being used by ATI Products, Inc. will be used to store raw material and service parts for Deere & Company's Moline manufacturing facilities.

The Company will retain 75 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$10,000,000.

Durata Therapeutics Inc.

Durata Therapeutics, Inc., a clinical development stage biopharmaceutical company, will relocate its headquarters from Morristown, New Jersey to Chicago, Illinois. The Company will create 25 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,200,269.

Ecolab Inc. and Subsidiaries

Ecolab Inc. and Subsidiaries senior management, due to the recent merger, evaluated a potential relocation of Illinois operations to other locations, including those in which there is already a significant group presence: Minnesota and Texas. The Company's global corporate headquarters are located in Minnesota along with a major research and development facility. Minnesota is a viable option as the Minnesota headquarters facilities and the Research and Development campus are more efficient facilities. The Company also has the ability to significantly grow its presence at the legacy Nalco Sugerland Energy Services facility in Sugerland, Texas. Similar to Minnesota,

Texas provides for more efficient facilities and a less expensive workforce. The Company elected to retain jobs in Chicago, Naperville, South Beloit and Joliet and add jobs in Chicago, Naperville and South Beloit.

Ecolab Inc. and Subsidiaries will create 50 full-time jobs above their current baseline of 1,919 full-time jobs (17 in Naperville, 22 in Chicago and 11 in South Beloit) and retain 1,500 full-time jobs (733 in Naperville, 154 in Chicago, 253 in South Beloit and 360 in Joliet). The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$35,024,000.

Farmington Foods, Inc.

Farmington Foods, Inc. is a fresh pork provider. Farmington Foods, Inc., through this project, will create 5 new full-time jobs, retain 122 existing full-time jobs and will invest \$2,000,000 at the Company's Forest Park, Illinois site.

Fresh Express Incorporated, a wholly owned subsidiary of Chiquita Brands International, Inc.

The strategic intent of the project is for Fresh Express Incorporated, a wholly owned subsidiary of Chiquita Brands International, Inc. to remove current redundant operations through the consolidation of its operations into a single facility. Current operations in Illinois are spread across four non-adjacent buildings all within the Village of Franklin Park. In addition the Company will increase automation that will allow Chiquita to respond to current market pressures streamlining production; therefore, becoming more productive and efficient. The Company elected to consolidate operations in Streamwood.

The Company will retain 631 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$39,760,305.

Grant Thornton LLP

Grant Thornton LLP has three offices in Illinois: an administrative and client servicing office in Oakbrook Terrace; a client servicing office in Schaumburg; and the corporate headquarters and client servicing office in Chicago. Grant Thornton LLP will relocate, consolidate and expand offices located in Chicago and Schaumburg into office space located at 161 N. Clark, in Chicago.

Grant Thornton LLP will create 65 full-time jobs above their current baseline of 506 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$23,031,548.

Hamilton Sundstrand Corporation

Due to the globalization of the aerospace industry and current corporate mandates to reduce overall costs, Hamilton Sundstrand, Inc. reviewed cost reduction and efficiency strategies to maintain competitiveness and to meet its business objectives. As part of this strategic review, Hamilton Sundstrand, Inc. reviewed a variety of existing manufacturing facilities throughout the world to determine if they should move a portion or all of its existing Rockford, Illinois operations to an out-of-state location, but decided against it.

Hamilton Sundstrand, Inc. will retain 1,500 full-time jobs (180 full-time jobs at 2421 11th Street, Rockford, Illinois and 1,320 full-time jobs at 4747 Harrison Avenue, Rockford, Illinois). The Company will make a \$30,000,000 Capital Investment.

Handi-foil Corp. and its Affiliates

Handi-foil Corp. currently occupies nearly a total of 600,000 square feet of space at two sites in Wheeling, Illinois – 135 E. Hintz Road and 1234 Peterson Drive. Handi-foil Corp. has outgrown these facilities and considered expanding its operations – either at a site at 2275 Diehl Road in Naperville, Illinois, or by relocating its entire operations to a larger facility in Wisconsin. Under the Naperville expansion scenario, Handi-foil Corp. will acquire an approximately 400,000 square foot facility to support Handi-foil Corp.'s operations. Handi-foil Corp. anticipates retaining both Wheeling facilities in the near term to continue to support the growing operations of its affiliate, HFA, Inc. (a.k.a. Handi-foil of America, Inc.), which manufactures and distributes aluminum foil pans and aluminum foil wraps used in the food service, bakery and packer processor industry.

Handi-foil Corp. will create 80 full-time jobs at the 2275 Diehl Road, Naperville, Illinois facility and retain 597 full-time jobs (347 full-time jobs at the 2275 Diehl Road, Naperville, Illinois facility, 200 full-time jobs at the 135 E. Hintz Road, Wheeling, Illinois facility and 50 full-time jobs at the 1234 Peterson Drive, Wheeling, Illinois facility. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$22,500,000.

Hanover Displays, Inc.

Hanover Displays, Inc. is looking to expand their operations. Currently, operations are performed at 358 and 365 Lively Boulevard, Elk Grove Village, Illinois. This location is leased and each address is only 3500 square feet. The Company will expand to a larger facility, approximately 25,000 square feet, to accommodate planned future expansion and growth. Hanover Displays, Inc. was considering sites in Indiana and Wisconsin, along with a new site in Elk Grove Village. The Company chose Elk Grove Village.

The Company will create 10 full-time jobs, retain 7 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,229,200.

Harman Becker Automotive Systems, Inc.

Harman Becker Automotive Systems, Inc. is building an R&D center focused on connectivity between smartphones and automobiles as well as advanced navigation technologies and Android software development for the car. These are all state-of-the-art innovation and technology roles that will help lead a transformation in the automotive industry. The Company selected Vernon Hills as the location for this new facility.

Harman Becker Automotive Systems, Inc. will create 100 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$12,795,304.

Heartland Dental Care Inc.

Heartland Dental Care Inc.'s ("Heartland") 40,000 square foot corporate headquarters is currently located at 1200 Network Centre Drive, Suite 2, in Effingham, Illinois and employs 162 full-time employees. This existing facility provides Heartland's team of more than 300 hometown dental practices with continuing professional education and leadership training along with a variety of management services which include staffing, human relations, purchasing, administration, financial, marketing and information technology support.

As Heartland's national footprint expands, the need to support these practices will require larger corporate headquarter support via both staffing and a larger facility. As a result, Heartland will lease an additional 38,000 square foot expansion to its existing Effingham, Illinois corporate headquarters.

Heartland Dental Care Inc. will create 80 full-time jobs, retain 193 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$7,735,749.

HMC Products, Inc.

HMC Products, Inc. was in a 44,000 square foot building in Rockford, Illinois and needed more space for future expansion. The Company will move to a 90,000 square foot building on a 7 acre lot in an industrial park on the Northeast corner of Interstate 90 and Hwy 173, which is located in Machesney Park, Illinois, which they chose over a potential site in Wisconsin for their future expansion.

HMC Products, Inc. will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 34 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,670,732.

Hub Group, Inc. and its Subsidiaries

Hub Group, Inc. and Subsidiaries operated in three locations in Illinois – Downers Grove, Lombard and McCook. Hub Group, Inc. encountered many operational inefficiencies which resulted from its workforce being spread across three locations. Each of the three leased spaces was inadequate in size for both their current and projected workforces. By relocating to a single location, Hub Group, Inc.'s employees, and the employees of its Subsidiaries, Hub City Terminals, Inc., Mode Transportation, LLC and Comtrak Logistics, Inc. are able to work together as efficiently as possible. The new building also provides modern facilities with the capability to expand as Hub Group, Inc. and its Subsidiaries grow.

Hub Group, Inc. needs a new corporate headquarters location for itself and its Subsidiaries. Hub Group, Inc. will acquire an approximately 17-acre site located at 2000 Clearwater Drive, Oak Brook, Illinois. Hub Group, Inc. will construct a new, approximately 120,000 square foot building on the site.

Hub Group, Inc. and its Subsidiaries (which include only Hub City Terminals, Inc. and Mode Transportation, LLC for this project), will create 18 full-time jobs, retain 300 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$33,809,872.

Hu-Friedy Mfg. Co., LLC

Hu-Friedy Mfg. Co., LLC has exhausted the available space in its Niles assembly, warehouse and distribution facility and explored all options for a potential retention/expansion in Des Plaines, Illinois or in Linden, New Jersey, and chose the Illinois location.

The Company will create 10 full-time jobs, retain 71 full-time jobs (42 from Niles and 29 from Chicago). The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$4,100,000.

Illinois Transport, Inc.

Illinois Transport, Inc. has outgrown its current location in South Holland, Illinois, which is both structurally and functionally obsolete, and needs to move to remain competitive. This move will include a longer-term home for both the Company's central office and its container repair operation. It will also expand operations and add new employees. Further, the Company needs to move closer to key customers. The Company explored sites in Hammond, Indiana and Wilmington, Illinois, but decided on the Illinois location.

Illinois Transport, Inc. will create 20 full-time jobs, retain 90 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$7,082,473.

Incredible Technologies, Inc.

Incredible Technologies, Inc. began its operations in 1985 with two employees. Since then, the Company has grown and became an expert in its industry. During late 2011, the Company conducted a strategic assessment of the business and its process, finalizing several aspects of its strategic plan. The Company determined that it had outgrown its current space within its Arlington Heights building. The Company also determined that a bigger facility, located in Vernon Hills will be necessary in order to accommodate its expansion plan and future growth.

Incredible Technologies, Inc. will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 119 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$7,343,977.

Indiana Sugars, Inc.

Indiana Sugars, Inc. will combine its sales office (currently in Burr Ridge, Illinois) and distribution center (currently in Gary, Indiana) into a single site location in Woodridge, Illinois to better serve their customers. This strategic initiative will, in effect, double the Company's current warehousing space allowing them to enhance its competitive position within its industry. The distribution center operations will be managed by a third party entity (Sweet Specialty Solutions, LLC).

Indiana Sugars, Inc. will retain 27 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,972,140.

Integrated Manufacturing Technologies, LLC

The project involves the construction of a steel metal building for Integrated Manufacturing Technologies, LLC in Red Bud. The building will be equipped with cranes that have a 40 ton capacity. The project will involve excavating existing concrete pad replacing it with new thicker slab to support the loads for the crane.

Integrated Manufacturing Technologies, LLC will create 50 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,157,082.

Intertape Polymer Corp.

Intertape Polymer Corp. is carrying out a facility rationalization plan that will result in more highly leveraged manufacturing cost structure by consolidating production in a lower number of manufacturing plants. Two plants were considered for closure: Carbondale, Illinois and Richmond, Kentucky. The production from the plant that is closed will primarily be transferred to the plant that is not closed (a small portion of the production will be transferred to an existing plant in Danville, Virginia). Investments will be made in the plant that remains open in order to accommodate the new business. The Richmond, Kentucky site was chosen to be closed.

Intertape Polymer Corp. will create 37 full-time jobs, retain 68 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,052,500.

Iroquois Industrial Group, LLC

Iroquois Industrial Group, LLC was considering the purchase of T&D Metals with the relocation of its operating facilities and 80 jobs to Indiana in order to reduce operating costs, increase efficiency and profitability. The total cost of operations in Illinois is more expensive than relocating operations to another state. The Company currently operates out of three buildings which total 190,000 sq. ft. in Watseka, Illinois and could easily relocate to another location outside the State of Illinois and consolidate all of their functions under one roof. However, Iroquois Industrial Group decided to remain in Watseka.

Iroquois Industrial Group, LLC will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 80 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,208,026.

IVZ, Inc. & Subsidiaries

On June 1, 2010, Invesco Ltd. acquired Morgan Stanley's Retail Asset Management Business, including Van Kampen Investments. The Van Kampen acquisition was accretive to Invesco Ltd.'s business, but required significant adjustments to the operations and deployment of people.

In the Chicago, Illinois area, IVZ added the Morgan Stanley/Van Kampen operation located in Oakbrook Terrace to its other existing operations in Wheaton and downtown Chicago, Illinois. IVZ, Inc. & Subsidiaries currently has three facilities in Illinois. A downtown location on South Wacker Drive is not part of this EDGE project.

IVZ, Inc. & Subsidiaries applied for and secured an EDGE Tax Credit Agreement in 2010. In exchange for the tax credits, IVZ committed to retain 83 employees at a site in Oakbrook Terrace and make more than \$3 million in capital investments at that site. Invesco continued to examine its business operations in all markets and subsequently created a new realignment plan for its Chicago area businesses. In 2012, Invesco decided to consolidate its existing facilities in Wheaton, Illinois and Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois, to create a new location in Downers Grove, Illinois. With consolidation, Invesco Ltd. would pursue numerous benefits already achieved in other key locations, like Houston, Texas, including: space efficiencies; elimination of duplication; personnel integration; “one company” business culture improvements; greater security for corporate and customer data; improved facility quality for employee attraction and retention; and cost savings.

IVZ, Inc. & Subsidiaries will retain 83 full-time jobs (all from Oakbrook Terrace, Illinois), and make a Capital Investment of \$24,454,981.

James Hardie Building Products, Inc. #3

To execute its global strategy of offering differentiated products with superior value, James Hardie Building Products Inc. will establish a Technology Center as a compliment to its existing Research and Development center in California. James Hardie Building Products Inc. was considering a number of states in the Midwest, including Illinois, Missouri and Wisconsin as well as states where it currently has a significant presence, including Texas.

The Technology Center facility will be approximately 40,000-60,000 SF in size at a minimum and will include state-of-the-art labs, research equipment and product pilot lines, focused primarily on breakthrough fiber-cement technology research and development.

James Hardie Building Products Inc. will create 12 full-time jobs, retain 5 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$9,250,000.

Johnstone Supply, Inc.

Johnstone Supply, Inc. is a cooperative wholesale distributor in the United States and a leader in the HVACR industry.

The project involves the establishment of a new 200,000 square foot Midwestern U.S. regional distribution center. Locations considered for the project include Joliet, Illinois; Davenport, Iowa; and Indianapolis, Indiana, with Davenport serving as the primary alternative. Johnstone Supply decided to lease an existing building in Joliet pursuant to a 10-year lease.

The Company will create 35 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$7,671,314.

Jump Operations, LLC

Jump Operations, LLC is expanding its operations in Chicago given its central location and access to a great workforce. Jump Operations, LLC will continue expanding its trading operations, both

nationally and globally. Because the Company's business also demands the use of specialized and sophisticated technology, Jump Operations, LLC will incur significant costs to build out space that is appropriate for the Company's use. The Company chose to enter into a long term lease at 600 West Chicago Avenue in Chicago for additional space at their existing headquarters in order to accommodate their expansion needs over moving to New York.

Jump Operations, LLC will create 40 full-time jobs above their current baseline of 305 existing full-time jobs. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$5,013,623.

Kraft Foods Group, Inc. f/k/a Kraft Foods Global, Inc. #2

Kraft Foods Group, Inc. will close and relocate its Tarrytown, New York administrative office. The 330,000 square foot facility currently houses professionals of the Beverages Business Segment as well as a number of research technology professionals. The Beverage Business Segment employees will be relocated to Northfield, Illinois (the headquarters) and Glenview, Illinois. In addition, it is anticipated that Kraft Foods Group, Inc. will move its Planters business unit operations from East Hanover, New Jersey, to Northfield and Glenview and consolidate a number of jobs in the headquarters facility. The business rationale for the project is to further centralize GroceryCo's (new spin-off Company) U.S. operations in the Chicago-land area.

Kraft Foods Group, Inc. will create 150 full-time jobs (130 in Northfield and 20 in Glenview), and make a Capital Investment of \$20,000,000.

Lafarge North America, Inc. #2

Lafarge North America Inc. will relocate its U.S. corporate headquarters to a site close to its existing operations and customers. The project site is 8700 West Bryn Mawr Avenue, Chicago. The Company also explored alternative sites in Johnson County, Kansas, and Oakland County, Michigan.

The Project will result in the creation of 90 new full-time jobs at the Illinois project site. Additionally, the Company will invest \$8,349,018 in capital funds in Illinois.

Lehmann-Peterson Corporation

GM-Cadillac Division approached Lehmann-Peterson Corporation requesting that the Company provide custom coach building services for its newly designed Cadillac XTS. The parties have reached an agreement that allows Lehmann-Peterson Corporation to provide the redesign of the XTS utilizing a mid-body stretch of several inches.

Lehmann-Peterson Corporation will acquire a building located at 3737 Industrial Drive, Rolling Meadows, Illinois. The acquisition of the building will give the Company the square footage to manufacture its custom coaches in a cost effective manner.

Lehmann-Peterson Corporation will create 45 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,505,000.

Lending Solutions, Inc.

Lending Solutions, Inc. is committed to expand its business to accommodate the increased demand for its services. Lending Solutions, Inc. currently has a facility located in Elgin, Illinois that employs approximately 240 full-time people. This facility is at full capacity and Lending Solutions, Inc. intends to continue operating the Elgin office at full capacity.

Lending Solutions, Inc. will hire at least 86 new full-time employees to meet increased client demand for its services. Because its Elgin location is already operating at full capacity and also because Lending Solutions, Inc. needs disaster recovery/backup protection, the Company will house these new employees in a separate new facility that is at least 10 miles from its Elgin facility.

To accomplish their goals, Lending Solutions, Inc. will lease a site in Naperville, Illinois for 20,879 square feet of space that would operate 24 hours per day, 363 days per year.

Lending Solutions, Inc. will make a Capital Investment of \$2,736,479.

LSL Industries, Inc.

LSL Industries, Inc. will move its existing facility from Evanston, Illinois to 5740-50 N. Tripp, Chicago, Illinois over a Wisconsin location. LSL Industries, Inc. will also remain at its current 5535 N. Wolcott, Chicago, Illinois address.

The Company will create 20 full-time jobs (14 at Wolcott and 6 at Tripp), retain 93 full-time jobs (84 at Wolcott and 9 at Tripp), and make a Capital Investment of \$2,973,459.

Lyons Consulting Group, LLC

Lyons Consulting Group, LLC will continue to expand its consulting operations in Illinois. The Company's growth relies heavily on accessing and recruiting talented individuals, and Lyons Consulting Group, LLC needs to acquire additional space in a location that provides access to these talented individuals. The Company's current facility in Chicago, Illinois cannot accommodate the planned growth as it does not have enough space even for its current employment. Therefore, the Company will relocate to a larger building in Chicago.

Lyons Consulting Group, LLC will create 50 full-time jobs, retain 53 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,212,983.

Magnetrol International, Inc.

Magnetrol International, Incorporated's increased sales volume and anticipated future growth are the primary reasons that the Company has an immediate need to increase capacity. The Company currently has a total of just over 100,000 square feet in two Downers Grove, Illinois facilities; approximately 85,000 square feet at their main facility at 5300 Belmont Road and another 20,000 square feet of leased space located at 5408 Janes Avenue. Magnetrol International, Incorporated's will consolidate current facilities and add a minimum of 50,000 square feet of

additional capacity into one larger facility. The Company chose a facility in Aurora, Illinois, that has 220,000 square feet of combined office, production, and warehouse space all on one level.

Magnetrol International, Incorporated will create 30 full-time jobs, retain 293 full-time jobs, and make a Capital Investment of \$14,750,000.

Mid-Am Building Supply, Inc.

Mid-Am Building Supply, Inc. currently leases a facility which is located at 300 E. McCord Street, Centralia, Illinois. The Company's current facility is 40,000 square feet but is no longer large enough to accommodate the Company's continued growth. Mid-Am Building Supply, Inc. will lease (from common ownership) a 140,440 square foot building on 8.96 acres which is located at 2425 South Wabash, Centralia, Illinois.

Mid-Am Building Supply, Inc. will create 5 full-time jobs and retain 31 full-time jobs. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$990,278.

Motherboard Express Company d/b/a MBX Systems, Inc.

Motherboard Express Company d/b/a MBX Systems, Inc. currently has 74 full-time employees located in one facility in Wauconda. The Company has outgrown the facility and is in need of additional space. A new facility is required in order to remain efficient and competitive. The Company has considered alternative locations in Wisconsin, but decided on Illinois.

The Company will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 74 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,681,850.

Narita Mfg., Inc.

Narita Mfg., Inc. is a start-up metal fabricating and finishing company. The Company will be making the final assembly car train for Nippon Sharyo U.S.A. The final assembly will be for the Chicago Metra High Liner.

Narita Mfg., Inc. will create 20 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$1,994,816.

Portillo's Food Service, Inc.

Due to the success of the Portillo's brand, Portillo's Food Service, Inc. must update and expand its food service facility in order to accommodate Company growth and demand for additional supply of food service requests. This will be accomplished by using state of the art equipment and will enable the facility to supply to more than 50 restaurants in the next year. The Company has outgrown its Addison building, added a second location in Aurora, Illinois. They have chosen to replace the original facility in Addison, Illinois over relocating to Merrillville, Indiana.

Portillo's Food Service, Inc. will create 20 full-time jobs in Addison, Illinois and retain 94 full-time jobs (30 in Addison, Illinois and 64 in Aurora, Illinois). The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$10,150,000.

Pres-On Corporation

Pres-On Corporation is unable to remain and/or expand at its current locations, because the site is landlocked, as well as, structurally and functionally obsolete. The Company will lease a site in Woodridge, Illinois (from common ownership), that will allow it to combine its three current sites in Addison within a single unified structure. This project is necessary to allow the Company to better service its customers and remain competitive.

Pres-On Corporation will retain 67 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,433,753.

Quad/Graphics Inc.

Quad/Graphics Inc. is making investment decisions across its North American portfolio. Locations selected for investment and job growth will become the most efficient plants in the United States. This industry is extremely competitive thus maintaining a low cost of operations is critical to success. The Company has decided to invest in Effingham, Illinois.

Quad/Graphics Inc. will create 25 full-time jobs, retain 520 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,000,000.

Rockford Products, LLC

Rockford Products, LLC (Rockford) initially considered moving its operation to Wisconsin two years ago, prompted by an acquisition opportunity that did not materialize. Although the relocation idea was postponed, the notion of Rockford leaving the Rockford, Illinois location remained under active consideration by the Company and its owner, Black Eagle Partners. Recently, the prospect of relocation gained considerable momentum.

Consequently, Rockford and Black Eagle Partners were faced with determining where the most stable and cost-competitive environment exists, Illinois, Michigan or Wisconsin. Ultimately, the Company elected to expand in Illinois.

Rockford Products, LLC will create 95 full-time jobs, retain 271 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$12,295,920.

Royal Die & Stamping Co., Inc.

Royal Die & Stamping Co., Inc. is being forced out of its existing building in Bensenville, Illinois, due to the construction of the Elgin-O'Hare expansion/western bypass being built. The State is buying the Company's land and property to allow the bypass to run through the Company's property.

Royal Die & Stamping Co., Inc. will relocate to Carol Stream, Illinois, as the facility in Carol Stream, Illinois offers almost twice the space as its existing building which is at capacity. The new building is approximately 150,000 square feet; its existing building is about 80,000 square feet. Carol Stream, Illinois offers easy access to major highways and transportation hubs. Royal Die & Stamping Co., Inc. will retrofit the building to suit their needs and anticipates growing in the new location.

Royal Die & Stamping Co., Inc. will create 20 full-time jobs, retain 142 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$8,450,000.

salesforce.com, inc.

Given its rapid growth, salesforce.com, inc. considered the feasibility of establishing a Mid-America Corporate Sales Office. This aforementioned feasibility process began in the summer of 2011 and as a result, one location in the City of Chicago (111 W. Illinois St.) was chosen for the project, over Atlanta, Georgia and Phoenix, Arizona.

The building in Chicago, Illinois has a total of 224,000 square feet of office space, of which salesforce.com, inc. will occupy 117,000 square feet (formerly vacant and never before occupied) to support its long-term operational requirements.

salesforce.com, inc. will create 200 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$49,906,879.

Sears Holdings Management Corporation

Sears Holdings Management Corporation operates a headquarters facility in Hoffman Estates, Illinois, with a satellite operation at 1 North State Street in Chicago, Illinois. Sears Holdings was contemplating a relocation and possible sale of its existing facility into a lower-cost alternative site in Columbus, Ohio, but the company elected to remain in Illinois.

Sears Holdings Management Corporation will retain 4,250 full-time jobs. Sears Holdings Management Corporation will make a Capital Investment of \$60,000,000.

Sewer Equipment Company of America

Sewer Equipment Company of America has developed a number of new products and added additional sales engineers that have allowed the company to compete in a number of new markets. These new markets along with future product development plans, is the driving force behind the facility expansion requirements. As a result, the Company will expand it Dixon, Illinois location.

Sewer Equipment Company of America will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 70 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,024,692.

Shank Screw Products Co.

Over the past three and a half years, Shank Screw Products Co. embarked on a major program to reposition the company to become more competitive in the market place. The Company's goal was to build a stronger foundation in the Midwest (preferably Illinois) which they could use as a showcase to leverage the organization into new clients and new manufacturing industries.

To get to the next level, and to enter new markets, Shank Screw Products Co. will increase its manufacturing capabilities, find a new facility that will provide room to grow, and support the addition of more modern technology, such as "clean rooms".

Shank Screw Products Co. will create 5 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$1,500,000 in Aurora, Illinois.

Shopper Trak RCT Corporation

ShopperTrak RCT Corporation will expand operations in Illinois over its lower cost alternative location in Shenzhen, China. The Company's operations and information technology positions can be performed at either location or its existing location in China can easily accommodate this requirement.

ShopperTrak RCT Corporation will create 25 full-time jobs, retain 50 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$8,533,558 in Chicago, Illinois.

Snap-on Incorporated & its Affiliates & Subsidiaries #2

Snap-on Incorporated will expand operations at three Illinois facilities in Crystal Lake, Libertyville and Lincolnshire. The Crystal Lake facility primarily serves as a distribution, customer care and repair center. The Libertyville facility provides financial and captive credit services. The Lincolnshire facility provides engineering design. Furthermore, Snap-on is expanding its Lisle datacenter facility which provides off-site data storage and cloud computing support services to Snap-on. The high-security facility is operated remotely and will help support the expansion at the Crystal Lake, Libertyville and Lincolnshire facilities.

The Company will retain 693 full-time employees and make a Capital Investment of \$4,945,000. Crystal Lake will retain 476 full-time employees, Libertyville will retain 165 full-time employees and Lincolnshire will retain 52 full-time employees.

Sokol & Company, Inc.

Sokol & Company's existing facility can no longer meet the Company's production requirements and space needs. The Company will relocate to a larger, more efficient facility. The Company evaluated expanding its Illinois locations by leasing additional space (5301 Dansher Road, Countryside, Illinois) near its current facility or relocating its entire operations to a new location in Crown Point, Indiana. The Company selected the Countryside location.

Sokol & Company, Inc. will retain 93 full-time jobs between the 5315 and 5301 Dansher Road, Countryside, Illinois facilities. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$1,053,491 at the 5301 Dansher Road facility. The Company will be leasing from common ownership.

Sunstar Americas, Inc.

Sunstar Americas, Inc. is building a new North American Headquarters and a high technology manufacturing operation that will enable the Company to move into the 21st Century and expand into new lines of oral health related products involving cutting edge technologies.

The project involves construction of a new North American Headquarters and major manufacturing facility in Schaumburg, Illinois, at I-90 and Roselle Road. In doing so, Sunstar Americas, Inc. will create an additional 25 full-time jobs in Illinois as well as retain its existing 335 full-time jobs. Sunstar Americas, Inc.'s new headquarters and manufacturing facility will sit on an 80-acre campus. Sunstar Americas, Inc. will move 315 full-time jobs from Chicago, Illinois and 20 full-time jobs from Elgin, Illinois to the new Schaumburg, Illinois facility.

The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$35,145,000.

Sweet Specialty Solutions, LLC

Sweet Specialty Solutions, LLC is trying to secure additional manufacturing business from its customer base, specifically for their packaging and blending operation. Accordingly, the Company needs to expand its current "start-up" packaging and blending operations. There is no space available at its current location (1005 101st Street, Woodridge, Illinois), for such an expansion. The Company has identified a building adjacent to its current facility where the Company can lease space for their expansion.

Sweet Specialty Solutions, LLC will create 30 full-time jobs above their current baseline of 18 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,752,683.

TACT Holding, Inc. & Affiliates

TACT Holdings, Inc., through its affiliates World Class Distribution, Inc. & Trader Joe's East, Inc., will build a new warehouse which will serve as a regional distribution facility for its grocery stores in the Midwest. The warehouse will be a 600,000 square-foot facility with 100,000 square feet of frozen food storage. A new warehouse in the Chicago area will allow Trader Joe's to increase its service to the area.

TACT Holding, Inc., through its Affiliates will create 500 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$58,000,000 (through its Affiliate, World Class Distribution, Inc.).

TerraSource Global Corporation

TerraSource Global Corporation has experienced significant growth over the past few years. The Company's current facility does not support their current or long term goals and an expansion or

relocation needs to occur very quickly. The expansion will add 6,000 sq. feet of office and training space on two floors, including elevator access.

TerraSource Global Corporation reviewed multiple out of state options that would leverage its parent company, Hillenbrand Inc., resources. The company chose Belleville, Illinois over other sites in Indiana, Tennessee, Ohio, Pennsylvania, and South Carolina.

TerraSource Global Corporation will create 10 full-time jobs, retain 84 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$5,500,000.

The Federal Savings Bank

The establishment of The Federal Savings Bank National Home Loan Center Headquarters required the expansion of the Company's existing Chicago office operations at 300 N. Elizabeth St., Chicago, Illinois. The current office space leased at 300 N. Elizabeth St. is 26,369 square feet and can accommodate an employee workforce of 165 based on the current office configuration. Based on the Company's expected full-time employee expansion, additional leasing space will be needed. At the present time, there are additional leasing spaces available at the property at 300 N. Elizabeth St., Chicago, Illinois.

The Federal Savings Bank provides competitive residential home loan products to customers in all 50 states as it looks to expand office operations to the State of Maryland, Minnesota, and New Jersey and expands products in full service banking.

The Federal Savings Bank will create 300 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$10,611,847.

Tyco Healthcare Group LP d/b/a Covidien

This project is in alignment with the Covidien corporate restructuring initiative to reduce manufacturing costs, by improving operating efficiencies in the Medical Supplies segment. The project will involve the closure of the existing manufacturing plant in Commerce, Texas and the transfer and start-up of the Commerce, Texas production equipment in the existing Covidien facility in Crystal Lake, Illinois. The Company will diversify and expand existing manufacturing operations at the Crystal Lake plant to include syringe manufacturing.

Covidien will create 115 full-time jobs above their current baseline of 305 and make a Capital Investment of \$30,264,093.

USG Corporation

USG Corporation has been in its Libertyville Corporate Innovation Center facility since the 1980's and the facility is over 40 years old. USG Corporation considered upgrading the facility in order to continue developing innovative building materials, and was also looking at locations elsewhere, including Indiana and Wisconsin. USG elected to expand its Libertyville facility.

USG Corporation will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 80 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$11,535,373.

Versatch, LLC

Versatech, LLC has recently been awarded two projects to manufacture Honda Front Knuckles for the CRV and Civic Si automobiles. These two projects will require a significant amount of capital investment, as well as, production floor space. Due to the space requirements, Versatech, LLC will need to expand its current operations. After analyzing the options of adding on to its existing facility, or moving to a new facility, it has been decided that moving to a different facility is more cost competitive. Versatech, LLC has chosen the location in Effingham, Illinois that would meet its needs, over locations in Terre Haute, Indiana and Brazil, Indiana.

Versatech, LLC will create 20 full-time jobs, retain 38 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$5,251,276.

Vosges, Ltd.

Vosges, Ltd. has outgrown its current manufacturing and headquarters facility located at 2211 N. Elston in Chicago. The current lease is expiring and the manufacturing use is incompatible with other uses in the building. Vosges, Ltd. requires new space for its current operations and future growth.

Vosges, Ltd. chose Illinois over Tennessee and will move its manufacturing and headquarters to a different site within Chicago, 2950 N. Oakley. The Company will retain its current 36 manufacturing and headquarters full-time employees, and create 35 new full-time jobs. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$3,156,020.

Woodward, Inc.

This is a “multi-site” project, located in Illinois that represents the expansion of Woodward, Inc. Aircraft Turbine Systems division. Specific addresses involved shall include 5001 North Second Street, Loves Park, Illinois, 12533 Wagon Wheel Road, Rockton, Illinois (temporary space) and a preferred Zenith Cutter location, which is located in Loves Park, Illinois. Projected growth in the airline industry and heightened demand for next generation narrow body jets has resulted in several significant program wins, with sales projected to triple by 2021.

Woodward, Inc. will hire 104 new full-time jobs, above the Company’s current baseline of 1,460 full-time jobs. Woodward, Inc. will create 21 full-time jobs and retain 200 full-time jobs at the Zenith Cutter facility and create 83 full-time jobs and retain 800 full-time jobs at the 5001 North Second Street, Loves Park facility. Woodward, Inc. will make a Capital Investment of \$46,000,000.
