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ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FOR A GROWING ECONOMY (EDGE) TAX CREDIT PROGRAM CALENDAR YEAR 2011 REPORT

One of the most successful economic development tools provided by the General Assembly and Governor Pat Quinn is the Economic Development for a Growing Economy (EDGE) Tax Credit Program.

The EDGE Tax Credit Program is a targeted tax incentive program that provides tax credits for businesses that create new full-time jobs, retain existing full-time jobs and make capital investments in Illinois. The EDGE Tax Credit Program is designed to help areas of Illinois that are in direct competition with other states for jobs and development.

The following report identifies the guidelines and accomplishments of the EDGE Tax Credit Program.

EDGE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The Illinois Economic Development for a Growing Economy (EDGE) Tax Credit Program is intended to help the state compete with other states for the location of job creation or retention projects.

The Illinois EDGE Tax Credit Program is operated by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity. Based on a review of a written application submitted by an interested firm, the Department is authorized to designate qualified businesses as “eligible”. Eligible businesses may claim a nonrefundable tax credit against their state income taxes. (The amount of the tax credit is calculated based on the income taxes paid by new employees and the retained employees.)

The designation is contingent upon the business undertaking a development project that:

- Involves at least \$5 million investment in capital improvements placed in service in Illinois and employs at least 25 New Full-Time Employees within the state as a direct result of the project; or
- Involves at least a \$2.5 million investment in capital improvements placed in service in Illinois and employs at least 50 New Full-Time Employees as a direct result of the project; or
- Involves an investment in a sufficient amount to employ at least 25 New Full-Time Employees, provided the project is located within or serves a distressed area or hires low-income workers; or
- Involves an investment at a level specified by the Department in capital improvements to be placed in service; employs New Full-Time Employees within the state at a level specified by the Department; and provides substantial economic benefit to the state, as determined by the Department. The Director may approve projects that do not meet the minimum job creation and investment thresholds for an applicant meeting all other requirements in the Act, providing that one or more of the following conditions are met:
 - A) The applicant’s business is located in a distressed community with an unemployment rate which is higher than the state’s average; or
 - B) The applicant’s business is located in an area with limited economic development prospects as evidenced by prior and current development activities; or
 - C) Approval would support a business with potential to generate additional growth in the area and create jobs as a result of spin-off businesses; or
 - D) Approval would avert the loss of one of the area’s major sources of employment.
- Involves a company with 100 or fewer Full-Time Employees whose investment will be at least \$1,000,000 in capital improvements which will be placed in service at a designated site in Illinois and employ at least 5 New Full-Time Employees at a designated site as a direct result of the project.

COMPETITORS' TAX CREDIT PROGRAMS

Illinois' primary competitors for business locations and expansions are the bordering states of Kentucky, Indiana, Iowa, Missouri and Wisconsin. These states have similarly adopted tax credits as incentives for businesses locating or expanding operations. Those programs most similar to the EDGE Tax Credit Program in neighboring states are:

- Kentucky Rural Economic Development Act (KREDA) – Kentucky
- IA Industrial New Jobs Training Act – Iowa
- Economic Development for a Growing Economy (EDGE) – Indiana

Table I below shows the similarities of the programs and highlights the advantage of the Illinois EDGE Tax Credit Program:

The Table illustrates that the EDGE Tax Credit Program is competitive with those of bordering states. Other competing states in which Illinois was chosen as the final project site include the following: Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Kansas, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nebraska, Nevada, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Texas and Virginia.

DESCRIPTION OF EDGE PROJECTS

The following is a description of each project, which was approved in Calendar Year 2011, which began on January 1, 2011 and ended on December 31, 2011.

EDGE PROJECT INFORMATION

Advanced Technology Services, Inc.

The project includes a commitment to continue headquarter operations in Peoria, Illinois and grow employment in Illinois versus relocating to another state with a lower cost of doing business. The Company currently has operations in Greenville, South Carolina and Livonia, Michigan, and was considering these as options for the move of all or part of the headquarter operations.

The Company will create 25 full-time jobs, retain 200 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$10,609,718.

Alply Insulated Panels, LLC

Alply Insulated Panels, LLC will specialize in manufacturing metal panels that are used primarily on commercial buildings sold directly to general contractors. The Company's product is sold nationwide. The primary reason for wishing to relocate is to secure the optimum operating environment such that the business can be positioned to take advantage of the forecasted, rapid increase in demand for "green" construction products such as those manufactured by Alply.

Alply Insulated Panels, LLC will create 32 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$1,186,507.

American Bottling Company

American Bottling Company (a wholly owned subsidiary of Dr. Pepper Snapple Group, Inc.) currently has a distribution warehouse in Harvey, Illinois to support Dr. Pepper Snapple Group, Inc. American Bottling Company was considering relocating the site of the current warehouse to another site in Harvey or Valparaiso, Indiana, because the term of the current lease is scheduled to expire during the 3rd quarter of 2011. American Bottling Company will commit to retaining 189 full-time jobs at a new warehouse site in Illinois.

American Bottling Company will make a Capital Investment of \$1,840,022.

Archer Wire International Corporation

Archer Wire International Corporation is currently located in Bedford Park, Illinois. The Company is expanding its production lines and an additional building is needed. The Company has found a building in Tinley Park, Illinois, which would meet their space needs.

Archer Wire International Corporation will create 75 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$5,000,000.

Bankers Life & Casualty Company

Bankers Life & Casualty Company's existing location at 600 West Chicago has become functionally obsolete for the Company's purposes. Relocation from this existing location is necessary to eliminate unnecessary costs and increase office space efficiencies. Bankers Life & Casualty Company was considering relocating to either a downtown Chicago location or to its parent company's existing Carmel, Indiana campus. The Company will relocate its corporate headquarters from 600 West Chicago to 111 East Wacker Drive in Chicago, Illinois.

Bankers Life & Casualty Company will retain 480 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$13,639,881.

Barton Manufacturing, LLC #2

The project will transfer Barton Manufacturing, LLC's operations from an existing 25,000 SF facility to an 80,000 SF facility. The existing 25,000 SF facility will be closed upon the transfer. Barton Manufacturing, LLC is planning to lease 80,000 SF out of a total building size of 178,000 SF. The transfer is needed to accommodate growing demand for the product and facilitate the Company's growth objectives. The alternative is relocation of the entire business to the new owner's hometown area of Detroit, Michigan.

Barton Manufacturing, LLC will create 40 full-time jobs, retain 16 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,166,421.

BMO Harris N.A.

BMO Harris N.A. (formerly known as Harris N.A.) was considering options for consolidation of back office functions of its three Illinois sites which are located at 311 West Monroe, Chicago, 2000 Finley Road, Lombard, and 3800 Golf Road, Rolling Meadows, as well as their Wisconsin market. Due to the recent acquisition of M&I Bank, Harris NA needed to make major decisions about where to locate their information technology and service/call center functions. As the Company grows, certain jobs could be located or relocated to existing facilities already owned and occupied by M&I Bank in order to take advantage of operating and cost efficiencies.

BMO Harris N.A. will create 100 full-time jobs and retain 943 full-time jobs at their new facility in Naperville, Illinois. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$72,000,000.

Borg Warner Emissions Systems Inc.

BorgWarner Emissions Systems Inc. wishes to expand its operations by adding Emission Cooler manufacturing capabilities and expanding the existing EGR valve product line. BorgWarner Emissions Systems Inc., located in Dixon, Illinois, will create 50 full-time jobs to support this

expansion. Without this expansion, the Dixon facility would not be able to retain their existing 147 full-time jobs. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$8,206,000.

C & C Power, Inc.

C & C Power, Inc.'s rapid growth has resulted in the need to expand manufacturing operations. The Company, located in Elmhurst, Illinois is currently operating out of a 55,000 sq. ft. facility with a satellite warehouse of 30,000 sq. ft.

C & C Power, Inc. was looking at a location at 395 Mission Street, Carol Stream, Illinois, as well as a facility in Kenosha, Wisconsin. The building is 170,000 sq. ft., with 95% of the space being open manufacturing/warehouse area. The property contains additional land for expansion to 200,000 sq. ft. and three separate parking areas for visitors, employees and tractor trailers.

C & C Power, Inc. will create 10 full-time jobs, retain 35 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$6,862,091.

Catalyst Health Solutions, Inc.

Catalyst Health Solutions, Inc. has recently acquired a division of Walgreens, Walgreens Health Initiatives (WHI). WHI employs close to 335 people in the Chicagoland market and Catalyst. Catalyst has decided to relocate these employees from Deerfield into 1200 Lakeside Drive in Bannockburn because these positions will no longer be part of the Walgreens Company, so therefore must leave the Walgreens campus.

Catalyst Health Solutions, Inc. will retain 335 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$15,088,220.

Champion Laboratories, Inc.

Champion Laboratories, Inc. is relocating existing production lines and equipment from other non-Illinois facilities as a result of synergies related to the acquisition of Honeywell's Consumer Products Group (CPG). The Company also proposes to renovate a storage facility to create a distribution center to accommodate increased unit volume. The proposed expansion would take place at the following addresses: 200 South 4th Street, 301 Industrial Drive, and Highway 130 South, all located in Albion, Illinois.

The Company will create 250 new full-time jobs in Illinois through relocations offered to existing employees and the hiring of new employees. The 250 new full-time jobs to be created will be above the Company's current headcount of 1,140 full-time jobs. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$4,000,000.

Chicago Metallic Corporation

Chicago Metallic Corporation (CMC) is looking to retrofit a facility which they own in Bridgeview, Illinois, but is currently vacant. The proposed site in Bridgeview is located in a developed industrial park and no public infrastructure improvements are anticipated at this time.

Chicago Metallic Corporation will also remain at its current location in Chicago, Illinois. CMC will create 25 full-time jobs, retain 6 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$9,100,000 at the Bridgeview facility.

Coated Sand Solutions, LLC

Coated Sand Solutions, LLC ("CSS") is a Delaware limited liability company formed December 22, 2010. CSS is contemplating the construction of a new manufacturing facility in Rochelle, Illinois to coat silica sand with resins. The facility will distribute resin coated to customers and markets outside the State of Illinois. Proposed customers are Schlumberger, Halliburton, Weatherford, Baker Hughes, Superior Well Service and Pioneer. These customers will purchase resin coated frac sand from CSS to be used in the oil and gas well fracing process.

Coated Sand Solutions, LLC will create 40 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$23,000,000.

Continental Electrical Construction Company, LLC

Continental Electrical Construction Company, LLC currently has 80 full-time employees in three separate facilities. The Company would like to consolidate all three facilities into one facility in Oak Brook, Illinois. The current facilities are located in Skokie, Hillside, and Carol Stream, Illinois.

Continental Electrical Construction Company, LLC will create 2 full-time jobs, retain 80 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,932,842.

Continental Tire the Americas, LLC

Continental Tire the Americas, LLC is expanding their Continental Tire the Americas tire production operations, including the purchase of additional machinery and equipment, construction of additional production space and supporting infrastructure and the employment of additional individuals above and beyond the current employment base of 2,507 in Mount Vernon, Illinois.

Continental Tire the Americas, LLC is experiencing growth and demand for its tires within the NAFTA Region. As a result, it is developing a plan to increase its regional tire production capacity. The Mount Vernon expansion project would be the first step in this plan.

Continental Tire the Americas, LLC will create 444 full-time jobs and retain 320 full-time jobs. Continental Tire the Americas, LLC will make a Capital Investment of \$221,674,000.

Derry Enterprises, Inc. d.b.a Field Fastner Supply

Field Fastener Supply is looking to expand its current facility in Machesney Park, Illinois. The current facility is approximately 33,000 square feet. The expansion would add an additional 44,000 square feet to the facility, approximately 16,000 square feet of office space and 28,000 square feet of warehouse space. As part of the project, Field Fastener Supply is modernizing the existing warehouse by adding 4 more dock bays, advanced packing lines, and a 500 square foot quality lab with more advanced testing equipment.

Derry Enterprises, Inc. will create 15 full-time jobs, retain 46 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,289,443.

DeVry, Inc.

Due to the increasing demand for online education, DeVry, Inc. proposes to open another site for its online operations at 300 South Riverside Plaza, Chicago, Illinois, referred to as "Project Online – Phase III". Project Online – Phase III is expected to require at least 77,000 square feet of office space.

The employees from Project Online – Phase II that are located at 3300 North Campbell Avenue, Chicago, Illinois will be relocated to the site of Project Online – Phase III due to space constraints at the North Campbell address. None of the individuals covered under the Phase II EDGE Agreement dated May 1, 2008 will be claimed as part of this project.

DeVry, Inc. is seeking to expand its services and operations while at the same time reduce costs and increase efficiencies. The Company was evaluating several real estate options in and around the Chicago area as well as considering moving some to out of state locations. DeVry, Inc. will create 200 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$24,790,435.

Diageo Americas Supply, Inc.

Diageo is looking at its North American Manufacturing footprint for overall Supply Chain effectiveness and a more effective, more streamlined Innovation Process. This includes a review of current products, asset life, capability, and overall footprint with relation to its vendor/customer base.

The aim of the proposed project would be to transform Plainfield into Diageo's flagship manufacturing plant in the US. In the short term this transformation would include drawing volume from other sites across North America into the Company's Plainfield, Illinois location, with a particular focus on production of Diageo's specialty and new-to-market innovation products. The project will also ready the site to deliver most of Diageo's expected North American volume growth.

Diageo Americas Supply, Inc. will create 45 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$85,000,000.

Donprint, Inc. d/b/a Worldmark USA

Donprint Inc. d/b/a Worldmark USA is proposing to set up a Brand Protection printing facility. The new facility will be approximately 25,000 square feet with options for future expansion. The Company will produce products at a facility in Libertyville that will be transferred from a UK facility and new business developed within the USA. These products are designed and supplied to companies such as HP, Intel, RIM, and Nokia, on a Worldwide basis.

Donprint, Inc. will create 44 full-time jobs and retain 10 full-time jobs. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$2,661,447.

Dotomi, LLC

Due to a recent merger with ValueClick (parent company), Dotomi, LLC was asked by senior management to consider out of state options for its headquarter location. Dotomi, LLC will relocate its existing facility to another Chicago downtown location instead of a lower cost alternative option in Austin, Texas.

Dotomi, LLC will create 60 full-time jobs, retain 176 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$7,931,124.

Eakas Corporation

The addition of a plating line to Eakas Corporation's Peru, Illinois manufacturing facility location will compliment the Company's painting and hydrographic decorative technology and will help them to better serve the automotive industry in Illinois and North America.

Eakas Corporation will create 25 full-time jobs over and above their current baseline of 108 full-time employees. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$32,926,964.

ECF, Inc.

ECF, Inc. will establish a new corporate office in Columbia, Illinois. The other potential site for the corporate headquarters was Fenton, Missouri. The office will be new construction. The Company will create twenty new (20) full-time jobs, plus the owner/CEO. Total payroll for the 20 full-time employees will be approximately \$1,233,000. Capital investment in the new site is estimated to be \$970,000.

ECLI Products, LLC d/b/a Engineered Custom Lubricants

ECLI Products, LLC will be moving all of its USA operations from its existing location at 45800 Mast Street, Plymouth, Michigan to either 3851 Exchange Avenue, Aurora, Illinois. The Company had also considered a location in Plymouth, Michigan.

The project to move US operations to a new location is both a critical and strategic decision for ECL. Engineered Custom Lubricants has grown to a point where current capacity does not allow

the Company to meet current or future manufacturing volume requirements. ECL's current location is split into two facilities, which are both land locked for expansion. Additionally, due to the nature of the business and manufacturing quality standards required, the manufacturing facility needs to be upgraded to higher standards. The expansion and move to a larger facility will create the opportunity to make the upgrades through leasehold improvements.

ECLI Products, LLC will create 12 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$1,316,809.

Edward Don & Company

The project encompasses the moving to a new facility to house the Company's Midwest regional distribution center and the corporate operations for the Company. The corporate operations consist of accounting, human resources, accounts payable, accounts receivable, IT, national account management and supply chain operations. The location of the planned development is at the North East corner of the intersection of I-355 and I-55 in Woodridge, Illinois. The occupancy of this site will enable the Company to relocate its North Riverside, Illinois operation to a location that will enable them to retain their presence in the area while providing the Company a platform to continue to grow their business.

Edward Don & Company will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 393 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$19,138,097.

Evrax Inc. NA

Evrax Inc. NA proposes to relocate its North American corporate headquarters from Portland, Oregon, to 200 East Randolph in Chicago, Illinois.

Evrax Inc. NA was considering alternate locations in Delaware, where Evrax Inc. NA has established manufacturing facilities, and Denver, Colorado, near the Company's existing manufacturing facility in Pueblo, Colorado. Evrax Inc. NA does not currently have any manufacturing facilities in Illinois or the greater Chicagoland area.

Evrax Inc. NA will create 70 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$9,165,094.

Excel Foundry and Machine, Inc.

Excel Foundry and Machine, Inc. will be building a 108,750 square foot metal building that will be used as a product processing facility and warehouse located at 14463 Wagonseller Rd., Pekin, Illinois. The Company will be combining the receiving, parts prep, inspection (both internal and incoming), assembly, crating, storage and shipping departments. The Company will also build an 8,640 square foot two-story office building with furnishings.

Excel Foundry and Machine, Inc. will create 50 full-time jobs above their current headcount of 236 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$7,400,000.

FedEx Ground Package System, Inc.

FedEx Ground Package System, Inc. is planning to expand the operational capacity within North American network through 2014 by adding 6 new Hubs, 31 expanded/relocated hubs and 200 expanded/relocated pick-up and delivery stations. The proposed South Chicago Station project is a new station, which will expand the operational capacity within the Midwest market. This is a spin-off project which will impact three existing Illinois locations and one existing Indiana location. The spin-off will relieve capacity constraints in the Chicago metro market, allowing for future growth at all of the facilities. To facilitate the expansion, FedEx Ground Package System, Inc. would lease a build-to-suit facility in Romeoville.

FedEx Ground Package System, Inc. will create 27 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$14,500,000.

Fleetmaster Maintenance Inc. d/b/a Stripmasters Services Inc.

Fleetmaster Maintenance Inc. (FMI) is expanding operations from the current 20,000 square foot facility on Mueller Avenue in Decatur, Illinois to a 160,000 square foot space on 22nd Street in Decatur, Illinois, primarily due to potential increases in business from a number of customers including Caterpillar Decatur. Other customers include ADM, Decatur Foundry, Bodine Electric, Barton Mfg., and VAE Nortrak. New more modern equipment will allow for increase in production resulting in significant sales increases by expanding the FMI customer base to area within 1000 miles.

The current Mueller Avenue facility does not have enough land to accommodate the proposed expansion or to handle the massive increase in business expected as a result in installing new machinery. In the proposed 22nd Street Decatur location, adequate space is available to accommodate long term growth.

Fleetmaster Maintenance Inc. will create 15 full-time jobs, retain 10 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$5,415,842.

Follett Corporation and Subsidiaries

Follett Corporation has many operations in Illinois, including corporate headquarters and distribution centers. Follett Corporation currently has distribution centers at 2211 West Street, River Grove, 8999 Palmer Street, River Grove, and 225 North Avenue, Melrose Park. The upcoming lease expiration on the distribution center necessitates a search for a new distribution center location. Therefore, Follett Corporation was considering relocating its distribution center to Kenosha, Wisconsin or Aurora, Illinois.

Follett Corporation's business model allows the Company to locate its distribution operations anywhere in the United States. To maintain efficiencies, Follett Corporation would like to keep the distribution center and headquarters in the same state; however, the final site selection decision will take into account the cost of doing business, specifically the tax structures of both states.

Follett Corporation will retain 60 full-time Distribution Center employees and make a Capital Investment of \$20,020,172.

Follett Corporation and Subsidiaries

Follett Corporation currently maintains its corporate headquarter functions in three office buildings located throughout the western suburbs of Chicago – River Grove (175 full-time employees), Westmont (160 full-time employees) and Oak Brook (244 full-time employees). Moreover, the River Grove headquarter operations is actually housed in the same building as one of the Follett Corporation's larger distribution centers.

Follett Corporation was considering relocating due to lease expirations at its current locations which involves the separation of the distribution center and office functions as well as a recent management change. This change in management included re-prioritizing efforts and implementing cost-savings, promulgating a shift in corporate strategies and streamlining the Company's real estate footprint.

Follett Corporation will retain 579 full-time jobs between their Oak Brook, Illinois and Westmont, Illinois sites. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$14,720,174.

Forte Automation Systems, Inc.

Forte Automation Systems, Inc. is looking at expanding their business. The expansion will consist of the construction of a 6,000 square foot multi-use facility for research, manufacturing, and training during Phase I and the lease of a 40,000 square foot Super High Bay expansion for assembly during Phase II. All projects would be located on-site at Machesney Park Headquarters.

The Company will create 77 full-time jobs and retain 57 full-time jobs. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$7,109,019.

Fuchs Lubricants Co.

Fuchs Lubricants Co.'s corporate office and primary production facility is located in Harvey, Illinois. The corporate facility houses all administrative positions (including accounting, finance, payroll, purchasing, customer service, credit, marketing and IT), plus a significant portion of their technical department (R&D, Technical Service, and local Quality Control). The Harvey production facility is responsible for the production of the majority of the industrial lubricants sold by the Company's Industrial and Specialty sales divisions, other than graphite products (produced in Emlenton), and greases (produced in Kansas City, KS). The Company's Huntington, West Virginia facility produces industrial lubricants specifically for their Mining sales divisions.

Fuchs Lubricants Co.'s graphite based lubricants produced in Pennsylvania are a significant contributor to Fuchs' overall profitability, and continues to be an area of focus for new business development. They are currently near production capacity in Emlenton. In order to effectively support their intended new business development, the Company needs to invest in new equipment to improve production, and increase both production and storage capacities. The Company

evaluated whether they could effectively achieve their future objectives regarding graphite product sales by upgrading and expanding their existing facility in Pennsylvania, or by relocating the operations to an existing facility where they have better capabilities for continued future growth and expansion.

Fuchs Lubricants Co. will create 12 full-time jobs over and above their existing 140 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$7,000,000.

Full-Fill Industrics, LLC

In July 2010, ConAgra Foods, Inc. made the decision to reduce the number of plants in its Packaged Foods division from 42 to 19. The Full-Fill project is the result of ConAgra selecting Full-Fill as a more cost-competitive, high-quality third-party co-packer option for production of their private label and branded aerosol cooking sprays. Currently ConAgra produces this product in a 70+ year old, inefficient manufacturing facility in Rossville, Illinois. ConAgra considered other locations to move this production to, which included a current plant in Indiana, as well as, locations in Texas and Oklahoma, which would involve expansion in those areas.

The decision to award this business to Full-Fill Industries, LLC is the only option for this business to remain in Illinois. The project entails the construction of a 100,000 square foot addition to Full-Fill Industries, LLC's current facility in Henning, Illinois.

Full-Fill Industries, LLC will create 150 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$13,316,406.

Gelber Group LLC

Gelber Group, LLC intends to relocate its corporate headquarters from 141 W. Jackson Boulevard, Chicago, Illinois to 350 N. Orleans Street, Chicago, Illinois. Relocation is necessary because Gelber Group, LLC's current premises do not support its operation in a cost effective manner.

As part of that relocation, Gelber Group, LLC would retain at least 192 full-time employees. Also, given the Company's growth pattern, Gelber Group, LLC will create 20 full-time jobs over the next two years. Gelber Group, LLC will make a Capital Investment of \$19,563,752.

General Manufacturing, LLC

General Manufacturing, LLC is a newly formed limited liability corporation, built from an asset-only purchase of the bank-owned Grind Rite, which was located in Elk Grove Village, Illinois. General Manufacturing, LLC will provide manufacturing, machining and retooling services to industrial clients in the locomotive and diesel industries.

General Manufacturing, LLC was considering locating its operations in one of three different jurisdictions – Illinois, Iowa and Georgia – based on which location makes the most fiscal and operational sense.

General Manufacturing, LLC will create 40 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,207,480.

Grub Hub Inc.

GrubHub Inc. is expanding its operations. The Company currently leases space in Chicago, Illinois and is looking to lease an additional floor in the same building. GrubHub Inc. will create 70 full-time jobs, retain 65 full-time jobs, and make a Capital Investment of \$3,229,820.

H & M Hennes and Mauritz L.P.

H & M Hennes and Mauritz L.P. will create a new call center location at 600 West Van Buren Street in the City of Chicago. As part of the launch of a larger online business, H & M Hennes and Mauritz L.P.'s intent is to offer the customer one place to search for customer service. In the future, a customer will call one service number regardless of the location of the customer or what channel the query is. The Company considered locating in either Chicago, Illinois or Columbus, Ohio.

H & M Hennes and Mauritz L.P. will create 80 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,214,255.

HAVI Global Solutions LLC

HAVI Global Solutions LLC is expanding and retaining operations in Illinois. As the Company grows, HAVI Global Solutions LLC is looking to take advantage of operating and cost efficiencies. The Company had considered leasing property in a former Blue Cross Blue Shield facility in Milwaukee, Wisconsin at a much lower rate than the location within Illinois.

HAVI Global Solutions LLC will create 60 full-time jobs, retain 374 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$18,440,691.

Hematogenix Laboratory Services, LLC

Hematogenix Laboratory Services, LLC was founded in 2008 by three brothers. Hematogenix Laboratory Services, LLC is a specialty reference lab that specializes in cancer diagnosis and many other related testings. Since its inception, the Company has experienced significant growth and has added 42 new full-time employees in just four years. Hematogenix Laboratory Services, LLC is now a nationally recognized laboratory in this highly specialized medical field. The laboratory has outgrown its current space and is looking to relocate to a larger facility in Tinley Park to accommodate expansion plans and to become the premier oncology research laboratory in the nation.

Hematogenix Laboratory Services, LLC will create 10 full-time jobs, retain 42 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$6,848,721.

Hill-Rom Holdings, Inc.

Hill-Rom Holdings, Inc. reviewed options for the placing of 50 full-time higher level positions and functions. Most of these positions are located in its Batesville, Indiana offices. As a company experiencing significant growth, Hill-Rom Holdings, Inc. looked for a location where many of their executives can easily travel to global destinations. Proximity to a major airport and access to a strong talent pool to choose from are major factors the Company is reviewing to decide where to locate these positions. Currently, Hill-Rom Holdings, Inc.'s satellite office in Chicago has 13 full-time positions.

Hill-Rom Holdings, Inc. will create 50 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,407,760.

Innoventures, LLC

Innoventures, LLC (a start-up LLC), will do the following: 1) Fabricate and manufacture various mechanical, electrical, and sub-assemblies for F-35 JSF Assembly Unit. 2) Construction self contained units that will handle swine manure from hog farms and turn into bio oil. Technology will allow farmers to approach zero emissions and realize a revenue source from manure, and 3) Fabrication and assemble electro-mechanical machine systems used in the rehabilitation of patients with spinal cord or brain injuries.

Innoventures, LLC will create 60 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$1,400,000.

Interior Investments, LLC

During 2010, Interior Investments, LLC conducted a strategic assessment of the business and has finalized several aspects of the strategic plan. It has determined that Interior Investments, LLC has outgrown its current space within the building it leases located at 625 Heathrow Drive, Lincolnshire, Illinois. The Company determined that a bigger facility will be necessary in order to accomplish its expansion plan.

The Company had considered relocating its operations to Indiana in order to obtain a competitive cost structure for warehousing, distributing and servicing their products.

Interior Investments, LLC will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 69 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,602,461.

International Mulch Company

International Mulch Company needs to consolidate its two facilities into one location in order to save costs. Consolidating the two facilities will enable the Company to operate more efficiently and improve the Company's cash flow. While this is primarily a consolidation, International Mulch Company is still a growing company in its infancy.

International Mulch Company will create 20 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$600,000.

Iron Bridge Capital Management, L.P.

IronBridge Capital Management, L.P. currently leases office space at One Parkview Plaza, Suite 600, Oak Brook Terrace, Illinois. The Company will lease office space at the same location, but on a different floor. The Company also considered leasing office space in Nevada and Texas.

IronBridge Capital Management, L.P. will create 10 full-time jobs, retain 30 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$5,204,569.

JMC Steel Group, Inc.

JMC Steel Group, Inc. (JMC) recently completed an organizational restructuring that will position it to grow through acquisition, hire new employees, and improve customer service. JMC's recent restructuring aligns with the company's growth strategies in the non-residential construction, transportation and energy markets, while simultaneously enabling the addition of new brands or companies.

A move to Chicago will allow JMC to benefit from increased synergies through consolidation of its regional management offices there into one national headquarters location. Using its restructuring as a catalyst to streamline its efforts, JMC is considering many ways to expand its brand. As part of this effort, the Company will choose to relocate its national headquarters to Chicago, Illinois from Ohio.

JMC Steel Group, Inc. will create 25 full-time jobs, retain 50 full-time jobs (who will move from their existing 1855 E. 122nd Street, Chicago, Illinois facility), and make a Capital Investment of \$10,194,180.

John Boos & Co.

John Boos & Co. (JBC) considered relocating its headquarters operation to Thorp, Wisconsin or relocating to a more modern, updated building in Effingham, Illinois. The Company currently operates in 13 buildings on a 12-acre campus, which it has operated since the late 1800's. Relocating would allow the Company to incorporate efficiencies in its operations, as well as, take advantage of a more modern facility at the proposed location.

JBC will relocate its metal plant, warehouse and office space from its current facility in Effingham to another building in Effingham. The new building would require substantial updates and improvements to make it a functional workspace for the Company's operations. Such improvements include constructing a loading dock for shipments and deliveries and creating office space to house JBC's executives and other office personnel.

John Boos & Co. will retain 120 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,500,000.

Joseph T. Ryerson & Son, Inc.

The Company's existing location at 2621 W. 15th Place has become functionally obsolete for Joseph T. Ryerson & Son, Inc.'s purposes. Relocation from this existing location is necessary to eliminate unnecessary costs and increase office space efficiencies.

Joseph T. Ryerson & Son, Inc. chose to remain in Illinois, and to relocate its corporate headquarters from 2621 W. 15th Place, Chicago, Illinois to 227 W. Monroe in Chicago, Illinois. The Company will also transfer some existing jobs currently in Chicago, Illinois to 1050 Warrenville Road, Lisle, Illinois.

Joseph T. Ryerson & Son, Inc. will retain 116 full-time jobs (83 full-time jobs in Chicago, Illinois and 33 full-time jobs in Lisle, Illinois), and make a Capital Investment of \$9,208,083.

Kapak Company LLC

The project is designed to vertically integrate Kapak Company, LLC's printing, laminating and pouching operations by transferring their two existing facilities (i.e. Minneapolis and Elk Grove Village) into one larger facility (i.e. Hanover Park) in order to maximize operating synergies and efficiencies as well as providing a platform to support projected future growth in unit volumes.

Kapak Company, LLC will create 55 full-time jobs, retain 50 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$10,303,672.

LAB Development, LLC

LAB Development, LLC currently occupies a 45,000 square foot facility in Buffalo Grove. The Company will relocate to a larger (61,000 square foot) facility within Buffalo Grove in order to accommodate future projected growth. LAB Development, LLC will create 7 full-time jobs, retain 32 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,906,551 at its new office and warehouse facility.

Lawson Products, Inc.

In late 2010, Lawson Products, Inc. began to review its portfolio of Illinois facilities as it relates to efficiency and suitability for its long-term growth plans. As part of this review, it was decided that the Company would consolidate its Illinois distribution centers currently located in Des Plaines, Illinois, Vernon Hills, Illinois, and Addison, Illinois into a single new location. Lawson reviewed and rejected locations in Indiana and Iowa and then narrowed the focus to build-to-suit opportunities in McCook, Illinois and Pleasant Prairie, Wisconsin.

Lawson Products, Inc. will retain 350 full-time jobs at their new Chicago Headquarters site and retain 100 full-time jobs at their new McCook Distribution Center site. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$14,850,222 at their Chicago site. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$24,892,450 at their McCook site.

MacLean Investment Partners, LLC and Subsidiaries

The MacLean Investment Partners (MIP) Illinois investment is to be placed in the Tramec ("Tramec") subsidiary. Hill Fastener is a company whose owner is planning to retire. Tramec's proposed friendly acquisition offer would (1) stabilize the company and pose it for growth and (2) prevent the company from being offered for sale via the investment banking route, thereby ensuring future jobs are located in Illinois.

Tramec proposes to augment production capabilities in Illinois through acquisition of the assets of another business. Tramec proposes to acquire the assets and hire the former employees of Hill Fastener Corporation in Rock Falls, Illinois.

MacLean Investment Partners will retain 25 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$1,700,000.

MacLean-Fogg and Subsidiaries

The MacLean-Fogg and Subsidiaries project will be placed in the MacLean Vehicle Systems (MVS) Subsidiary. MVS will augment production capabilities in Illinois through direct investment in machinery and equipment. MacLean Vehicle Systems will create 25 full-time jobs (23 in two Savannah sites and two in Mt. Carroll).

MVS will make a Capital Investment of \$8,500,000.

Magnum Steel Works, Inc.

Magnum Steel Works, Inc. has outgrown their current facility and would like to expand at a new location in Mt. Vernon, Illinois to meet the demands of the emerging mining industry in Illinois, Indiana, and Kentucky. Magnum Steel Works, Inc. will build an 80,000 square foot building on 20 acres in the Rolland Lewis Industrial Park in Mt. Vernon, Illinois. This new location is on an improved truck route, closer to Interstate 57/64 with access to natural gas and also has access to adequate electrical service that will easily serve their current and future growth.

Magnum Steel Works, Inc. will create 20 full-time jobs, retain 32 existing full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,000,000.

Mark Anthony Brands, Inc.

Mark Anthony Brands, Inc. will expand their corporate presence from Seattle, Washington into a new Midwest headquarters in Illinois. This corporate headquarters will run the Mike's Hard Lemonade Company from a new Midwest location.

Given the tremendous sales growth of Mike's Hard Lemonade, the Company is relocating their corporate offices from Seattle to Chicago to be better aligned with their business footprint.

Mark Anthony Brands, Inc. will create 50 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,554,035.

MIQ Distribution, LLC

MIQ Distribution, LLC is executing an operating agreement with Samsung to provide supply-chain related services within a distribution facility in Romeoville, Illinois. If approved, Samsung would be the lease holder for the building.

MIQ Distribution, LLC will create 40 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$1,513,000.

Motorola Mobility, Inc.

Motorola Mobility Holdings, Inc. (MMI) is retaining the research & development and related support functions at its existing facilities in Libertyville and Chicago, Illinois. The main Libertyville facility will focus on R & D, marketing and sales of the mobile and home devices. The total project is \$600,000,000 in capital improvements and research and development expenses and will result in the retention of at least 2,500 jobs. The minimum full-time retained jobs of 2,500 will consist of 2,378 retained full-time jobs in Libertyville and 122 retained full-time jobs in its Chicago facility. The Company is eligible to receive EDGE Tax Credits for up to 3,400 retained full-time jobs.

Of the \$600,000,000 in total project costs, the Company will spend \$30,000,000 in Capital Investment.

Nalco Company

Nalco Company currently has a sale lease back through 2027 on its existing Naperville headquarters. The building is highly inefficient (707,366 rsf for approximately 1,000 employees) and very expensive to operate.

As a result, Nalco is considering numerous relocation scenarios for all or a portion of the Naperville area, as well as, its Clearing operation at 6216 W. 66th Place in Chicago. The project location is their current location at 1601 West Diehl Road in Naperville.

Whether Nalco Company purchases the facility (Nalco has an ongoing purchase option within its current lease) or simply continue to pay the net rent obligation and take the facility dark (avoiding significant annual operating expenses), Nalco has the opportunity to reposition its workforce in a new, efficient, state-of-the-art headquarter facility while lowering its operating expenses by tens of millions of dollars.

Nalco Company's Naperville facility is broken down into two distinct functions, headquarter/support functions (778 jobs in 529,333 rsf) and research (222 jobs and 178,000 rsf). It is not necessary that these functions be housed together in the future.

Nalco Company will create 132 full-time jobs at their Naperville, Illinois facility and create 18 full-time jobs at their Chicago, Illinois facility. Nalco Company will also retain 851 full-time jobs at their Naperville, Illinois facility and retain 149 full-time jobs at their Chicago, Illinois facility. Nalco Company will make a Capital Investment of \$57,000,000.

NCI Group, Inc.

The demand for Environmentally Friendly construction products and practices, or green building, has accelerated in recent years. NCI Group, Inc. (NCI) is a leader in this tide of change with innovation and expert consultation in the use of metal construction products and processes. The American Iron and Steel Institute reports that steel is the most recycled material in North America. However, green construction ideas go well beyond recycling. A building's design and construction methods, its end use and occupants' productivity, as well as, maintenance requirements throughout the life of the building are among the many considerations that have changed the way NCI works with their builders and designers. It has also been the catalyst for some of the new products they are developing, which help the users of their products meet their green building objectives.

NCI Group, Inc. will re-open a previously shuttered facility, which they own, in Mattoon, Illinois. The Company will create 25 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$15,600,000.

Novatronix Inc.

Novatronix Inc. is a growing manufacturing business requiring additional space along with additional equipment to not only maintain current sales levels but also to achieve projected growth over the next five years. Growth has come from a continuous investment in new equipment and personnel along with a total customer/quality focus to the operations.

The proposed Wood Dale facility would more than double the production square footage of Novatronix Inc. and provide the expansion space required not only to continue the Company's growth but also to meet their current demand. Novatronix Inc. is constrained in its existing facility and requires needs to hire additional employees and invest in additional equipment. The Wood Dale facility can also support higher quality operation by way of manufacturing in a controlled environment by installing and/or upgrading the existing mechanical systems prior to move in.

The owners of Novatronix plan to purchase the Wood Dale facility individually and lease the facility to Novatronix Inc.

Novatronix Inc. will create 10 full-time jobs, retain 27 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,250,465.

OfficeNation, Inc.

OfficeNation, Inc. is currently located in a 7,000 square foot facility in Northbrook, Illinois. The Company currently has 26 full-time employees and is in need of additional space in order to support their future growth plans. The Company's current location cannot be expanded due to a lack of land. OfficeNation, Inc. is proposing to move to a 17,000 square foot facility in Northfield, Illinois.

The Company will create 5 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,270,515.

PEAK 6 Investments, L.P. and Affiliates

PEAK6 Investments, L.P. and Affiliates will upgrade their existing headquarters office which is located at 141 West Jackson Blvd., Chicago, Illinois. The Company will create 34 full-time jobs and retain 303 full-time jobs. The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$5,561,975.

Rana Meal Solutions, LLC

Rana Meal Solutions, LLC will be establishing a fresh pasta manufacturing facility with the United States. The Company was considering the State of Pennsylvania for their manufacturing plant.

Rana Meal Solutions, LLC will lease a building in Bartlett, Illinois from a related entity that will purchase the property. The building needs substantial reconstruction to become a USDA approved facility. Rana will be making a substantial financial commitment to leasing the building and buying equipment.

Rana Meal Solutions, LLC will create 70 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$16,832,104.

SIC Recycling, Inc.

SIC Recycling, Inc. is a recycler and processor of non-ferrous materials including but not limited to copper and aluminum. The Company's primary operation is the purchase of scrap materials which are then processed, granulated and separated and sold as commodities to various end-users. The primary scrap material is end-of-life radiator coils that include significant copper and aluminum content. The scrap material is purchased from scrap yards, scrap dealers, HVAC manufacturing companies, HVAC service technicians and HVAC distributors. Purchasers of the raw material output include steel mills and metal fabricators. The Company will primarily buy and sell in the Midwest. The scrap materials and raw materials will be shipped to and from the site.

SIC Recycling, Inc. intends to build a new facility on five acres of land near the I-72 interchange at Overpass Road in Riverton, Illinois. The site was chosen because of its location away from residential areas and within close proximity to the interstate.

SIC Recycling, Inc. will create 25 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$3,953,488.

Silgan White Cap LLC

Silgan White Cap LLC's objective is to establish a long-term location for their Headquarters, which has been located in Downers Grove, Illinois since 1979. The current headquarters' facility consists of office space and an innovation center and is currently located at 1140 31st Street, Downers Grove, Illinois. With an inexpensive option to terminate the current lease in 2012 and unused capacity at the current facility, Silgan White Cap LLC began the investigation of more cost effective facilities. The current facility consists of approximately 42,000 square feet and houses the following functions for Silgan White Cap LLC: Corporate Administration (i.e. Executive Functions), Operations Administration, Sales, Product Performance, and Research & Development.

Silgan White Cap LLC will retain 58 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$4,011,486.

Simonton Building Products, Inc.

Simonton Building Products, Inc. has consistently looked for means to improve the Company's operational efficiencies and contain costs. Through acquisition, disposition, systems integration, workgroup consolidation and relocation, the Company's on-going efforts to manage operation efficiency and institute cost containment measures will remain in the forefront of management's planning efforts.

In response to competitive and economic pressures, Simonton Building Products, Inc. conducted an assessment of its current manufacturing facilities to correspond to the Company's market-place growth objectives. This included a review of current products, asset life, capability, and overall footprint with relation to its customer base. The Company weighed its options from a logistical and cost benefit analysis standpoint. Simonton Building Products, Inc. reviewed the costs of utilizing existing space in Oklahoma, West Virginia or Illinois to create and retain jobs.

SolRwind Corporation will create 50 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$6,700,000.

Sonoma Partners, LLC

Sonoma Partners, LLC technology and business process expertise position the Company for growth opportunities in both its core business services and provide an opportunity to expand into software development. By aggressively pursuing these opportunities, Sonoma Partners, LLC can both retain its current operations and provide opportunity for employment growth. To accommodate these growth opportunities and provide an environment to foster growth, Sonoma Partners, LLC needs expanded facilities.

Sonoma Partners, LLC will create 12 full-time jobs above their current baseline of 51 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$5,735,927.

South Holland Paper Company

South Holland Paper Company d/b/a South Holland Bakery Supply, is relocating to Crete, Illinois, which will enable the Company to more than double their square foot capacity. Since it is not feasible for the Company to add on to their current facility, they are forced to relocate. The new facility will enable the Company to grow its business and thus provide more jobs for the community.

South Holland Paper Company will create 5 full-time jobs, retain 12 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,300,000.

Eleven full-time employees will also be relocated from South Holland to Tinley Park. Steiner Electric Co. will create 7 full-time jobs, retain a total of 29 full-time jobs and make a Capital Investment of \$2,538,290.

Taphandles LLC will create 31 full-time jobs and make a \$4,180,183 Capital Investment in Bedford Park, Illinois.

Tennant Truck Lines, Inc.

The City of Colona is creating a new industrial park, of which Tennant Truck Lines, Inc. will be the first tenant. Within this new industrial park, the Company plans on leasing a new 17,500 SF facility that will combine three existing facilities located throughout the Quad Cities into one location. U.S. Bank National Association's growth in the City of Chicago has been significant over the past 10 years. The Company currently occupies two buildings located at the Rookery (209 S. LaSalle) and 550 W. Washington. Major business units in Chicago include Wealth Management & Securities Services, Wholesale Banking, Technology & Operations Services, Commercial Banking, and Commercial Real Estate.

At year-end 2010, US Bank completed acquisition of the domestic and European based securitization trust administration business from Bank of America. This acquisition establishes US Bank as a leader in the U.S. structured finance trust business and complements US Bank's current market position in the U.S. corporate and municipal trust business. This acquisition and projected growth in business demand are triggering the need for net new employment growth. Unfortunately, the Rookery and 550 W. Washington buildings do not have sufficient vacant space to accommodate US Bank.

The Company was looking at a new location in Chicago (190 S. LaSalle Street) or relocating to their headquarters in Minneapolis, Minnesota. The project involves the creation of 42 full-time jobs, the retention of 711 full-time jobs, and a Capital Investment of \$48,246,371.

U.S. Foods, Inc.

U.S. Foodservice, Inc. currently operates its corporate headquarters in Rosemont, Illinois and its "Shared Services Center" in Phoenix, Arizona. The majority of the new jobs that the Company will be creating arise from a corporate-wide program designed to centralize certain job functions currently being performed at each of the company's 60+ Divisions (i.e., its distribution centers across the country).

U.S. Foodservice, Inc. will create 410 full-time jobs (approximately 55 full-time jobs at their 9399 West Higgins Road, Rosemont, Illinois address and 355 full-time jobs at their 6133 West River Road, Rosemont, Illinois address). The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$17,124,027 at their 9399 West Higgins Road, Rosemont, Illinois location.

UCI International, Inc. & Affiliates

UCI International, Inc. is considering locating its headquarters in Fulton County or Forsyth County, Georgia or Lake Forest, Illinois. The Company proposes to create 50 new full-time jobs. The current headquarters is located in Evansville, Indiana. The new full-time positions will be a combination of potential relocated employees from non-Illinois locations and new Illinois based hires.

The Company will make a Capital Investment of \$1,943,063.

Walgreen Company & Subsidiaries

Walgreen Co. will be making a substantial investment in an e-Commerce Fulfillment Center in Edwardsville, Illinois. The project would involve leasing an existing facility in Edwardsville, which is approximately 300,000 square feet in size. The e-Commerce Fulfillment center would allow Walgreen Co. to better fill orders and accommodate customers who make purchases online. The project would establish a new distribution center for Walgreen's focusing exclusively on e-Commerce customers.

The project will create 30 new full-time jobs in Edwardsville. Walgreen Co. will make a Capital Investment of \$26,744,922.

Walgreen Company & Subsidiaries

Walgreen Co. and Subsidiaries is making a capital investment in the Greater Chicago Region Business Campus. The total campus encompasses twenty-seven buildings in Deerfield, Northbrook, Chicago, Buffalo Grove, Lincolnshire, Mt. Prospect and Bannockburn, Illinois. The facilities are old and in need of improvement. If the investment was made in Illinois, the project would create 100 full-time jobs within one year, 200 full-time jobs in two years, 500 full-time jobs within three years, and retain 1,500 full-time employees. Walgreen Co. and Subsidiaries will make a Capital Investment of \$20,000,000 within one year, a total of \$45,000,000 within two years, and a total of \$75,000,000 within three years.
