


# CHICAGO

Heralded as one of the great architectural cities in the world, Chicago is the place where Frank Lloyd Wright, Mies van der Rohe, Louis Sullivan and Dankmar Adler cut their teeth. Their legendary work has been more recently joined by Helmut Jahn, Harry Weese and a new generation of legendary architects. Linking it all together is the "El" train which circles downtown. One of the few cities bordered by a beach, Chicago's coastline is Lake Michigan. Just beyond the labyrinth of downtown canyons, the lake spreads out at the feet of the skyscrapers. Heading north along the lake, palatial mansions line the north shore. Chicago's suburbia provides vast variety--ranging from the Wright inspired architecture of Oak Park to the homey bungalows of the southwest side. Immigrants from around the world are drawn to the "City of Big Shoulders". Today, the antiquated storefronts and brick three flats of Chicago's ethnic neighborhoods continue to reflect their Old World heritage.
