### **Free “Unborn” Tickets Available**

A film made partly in Kankakee this year will have a free premiere at Movies 10 in Bradley on Jan. 8, thanks to the state.

The Illinois Film Office will host a screening of “The Unborn,” a horror film whose cast includes Gary Oldman, who was last seen as Inspector Gordon in “The Dark Knight.” Younger talents include Odette Yustman, from “Cloverfield” and Cam Gigandet of the television show “The O.C.”

They all were in scenes filmed at Shapiro Developmental Center in Kankakee in July.

“The Unborn” was shot in Illinois, accounting for more than 1,100 job hires and about \$10.7 million in Illinois spending, according to the state. However, a publicist for the movie told The Daily Journal no local firms were hired for the Shapiro shoot.

The R-rated movie was directed by David Goyer, one of the writers of “The Dark Knight.” It is a horror story of a young woman who fights a spirit that is slowly possessing her.
