Governor Quinn Statement on Shot Fired at Orland Park Mosque

CHICAGO – Governor Pat Quinn today released the following statement on the shot that was fired at the Orland Park Mosque:

“I am saddened to learn of the bullet that was allegedly fired through the dome at the Orland Park Prayer Center during Tuesday’s Fajr prayer and encourage a thorough investigation by law enforcement authorities.

“That bullet which shattered the solemn early morning reflection for these worshippers shatters the serenity and dignity of every Illinoisan.

“We should all be able to agree that there is no place in Illinois for hate crimes, intimidation and religious intolerance. We are all relieved that an arrest was made last month in the vandalism of several Lake County houses of worship and trust that the perpetrator in Tuesday’s Orland Park attack will be apprehended quickly as well.”
