II. Review Health Subcommittee meeting minutes from 3.13.13 (2:40p-2:45p)

III. Health Subcommittee Work Group Updates (2:45p-3:15p)

- Obesity Prevention Work Group
 - At last Work Group meeting, the Work Group made slight revisions to obesity objective in the Work Plan, but content stayed the same
 - Completed the health template as a group and presented to health subcommittee
 - Has set their next meeting date for June 6
- Oral Health Work Ad Hoc Group
 - At last Work Group meeting, the Work Group made the following revision to Work Plan: added developing a 0-5 curriculum through CCOHF's oral health education specialists (0-2, 2-3, 3-5 curriculum for parents and care givers to use)
 - Work Group developed and finalized oral health recommendations in parent engagement and brushing to DCFS. Recommendations will be brought to a later Health Subcommittee meeting
 - New co-chairs of the Work Group were announced: Anne Clancy, and Kim Bartolomucci will be co-chairing the Oral Health Work Group

Health Subcommittee Charge: The Health Subcommittee will develop strategies for 1) integrating health across early childhood systems and for 2) addressing gaps in health-related services that can be addressed by early childhood systems in order to support children's healthy development and school readiness. The Health Subcommittee will also define measurable outcomes for accomplishing these work priorities.

- The CCOHF will seek stakeholder input for a funded project to develop an oral health message for Chicago.
- Medical Home Ad Hoc Work Group
 - Work Group has been unable to meet, but will be planning to meet in the beginning of May
- IL Children’s Mental Health Partnership
 - Mental Health Consultation is still incomplete. The holdup is likely due to uncertainty around what is happening with ISBE’s PI programs and mental health consultation.
 - Individuals completed the health template for issues related to mental health and development and will present at the next meeting.
- Update preliminary research on credentialing and higher education curriculum
 - Member reports that ACCESS (a collaboration of community colleges) have an aligned curriculum of 7 core courses, and health, safety and nutrition course is one of them. Madelyn James will look into what is included in the health, safety and nutrition course at the community college level. Understanding is that while there may be little variance in course content on the community college level, that there may be a lot more variance in course content across 4 year institutions.
- INCCRRA survey
 - DHS accepted and included our questions in the provider survey. However, survey has not been distributed yet.
