IBHE Dual Credit

- IBHE Administrative rules
 - Public universities
 - Private institutions (proprietary/NFP)
 - Out-of-state institutions
 - Not public Illinois community colleges
- *Challenge*: Lack of comprehensive data
- *In Progress*: Data gathering on current dual credit offerings to develop a baseline

IBHE Dual Credit Authorization

- Operating Authority required
 - 10 higher education regions
 - Oversight of out-of-state institutions
 - IBHE authority (approval/revocation)

IBHE Dual Credit Authorization

Challenge:

- Local control
- High school-based partnerships

In Progress:

- Identify dual credit activity:
 - Collaboration with ISBE
 - Updates to the IBHE Fall Enrollment Survey

IBHE Dual Credit Standards

- Alignment with ICCB/ HLC/ NACEP
 - Faculty qualifications
 - Student preparation/placement
 - Course equivalency
 - Transferability
 - Distance Education

IBHE Dual Credit Standards

Challenge:

- Institutional compliance with the Act/Rules

In Progress:

- Development of a comprehensive communication plan
 - Institutions
 - key K-12 partners

IBHE Dual Credit Data

- Annual data reporting requirements
 - Number and types of courses
 - Sites of course offerings
 - Course enrollments
 - Faculty credentials
- Longitudinal student performance data

IBHE Dual Credit Data

Challenge:

- Dual credit work is currently ongoing

In progress:

- Integration of dual credit data in the Fall Enrollment Survey and the Illinois Longitudinal Data System
