

Proposed Open Meeting Act Procedural Rules:

Electronic Attendance and Attendance by Other Means

By procedural rule of the Child Support Advisory Committee, the meetings of the Committee shall be held jointly in Springfield and Chicago, at published locations, via the aid of videoconferencing equipment. Members may attend telephonically if they are not located in either location and if a quorum of members is in attendance at the Springfield and Chicago locations.

Public Comment

By procedural rule of the Child Support Advisory Committee, the Committee shall set aside a specific portion of each quarterly meeting for public comments. Public comments shall be limited to subjects on the meeting's agenda. The Committee may cut off a comment if it is irrelevant, repetitious, or disruptive. Reasonable time limits will be set upon the length of each comment. Members of the public who wish to comment do **not** have to sign up in advance of the meeting, but may if they wish.
