III. Director's Report: Director Julie Hamos gave several updates:

- Medicaid Enrollment:
 - 293,000 new members had signed up under the Affordable Care Act, including 98,000 enrolled in County Care.
 - Demographic data on new enrollees was shared, with additional information on the HFS website at <http://www2.illinois.gov/hfs/agency/Transparency/Pages/AffordableCareActEnrollment.aspx>
- Care Coordination:
 - It is expected that nine new Accountable Care Entities (ACEs) will be up and running by July 1st. An updated chart of what entities will operate where will be posted on Care Coordination page of the HFS website at <http://www2.illinois.gov/hfs/PublicInvolvement/cc/Pages/default.aspx>
 - The possibility of a roll out delay of July 1 (of MCOs and ACEs) was discussed
 - The University of Illinois has applied to become a Managed Care Community Network (MCCN)/ACE

- State Budget and Legislation:
 - A Medicaid Omnibus bill is expected before the end of the legislative session
 - Concerns about the budget: If the tax hike is not maintained, the Medicaid budget would be cut by 1.35 billion dollars and HFS would no longer be able to support up 479,000 clients.

- B. Mike Koetting gave an update on the Illinois Medicaid Redetermination Project. A new quarterly report with data through April 30, 2014 will be posted on the IMRP section on the HFS website:

Some initial problems with the redetermination process have been identified and are being addressed by HFS and Maximus (e.g. doubled sided forms returned via fax where only every other page was received). Clients who are canceled for failure to respond may contact Maximus within 60 days of cancellation to request for their case to be reinstated. An FAQ section on the website was suggested.
