

**PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS  
FOR ESTABLISHING MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES**

**STATE OF ILLINOIS  
DEPARTMENT OF HEALTHCARE AND FAMILY SERVICES**

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) is proposing a change in the methods and standards for setting payment rates for Division of Substance Use Prevention and Recovery providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service July 1, 2018 and after.

[Public Act 100-0587](#) provides for an increase in the Medicaid and non-Medicaid reimbursement rates. The rate in effect on June 30, 2017 will increase by 3% effective July 1, 2018.

These proposed changes will increase expenditures by approximately \$1.8 million based on current utilization patterns for mental health rehabilitative services provided in or by an alcohol or substance abuse provider.

Any interested party may submit questions or comments concerning these proposed changes in reimbursement methods and standards. All questions or comments must be submitted in writing within thirty (30) days of the publication date of this notice and addressed to:
