

PROPOSED CHANGES IN METHODS AND STANDARDS FOR ESTABLISHING  
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENT RATES

The Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services is proposing a change in the methods and standards by which the Department will reimburse providers. The proposed change is effective for dates of service on or after September 1, 2020.

The proposed change will stabilize the base reimbursement for professional services provided by government-funded universities. The change will impact the reimbursement for physician and dental services through practices operated by the University of Illinois and Southern Illinois University. The calculation will be determined from the average reimbursement rates for the largest contractual commercial insurance plans with each university.

The Department estimates this change will increase expenditures by approximately \$6,000,000. The proposed change is subject to approval by the federal Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and may be modified or revised during the approval process.
