


The stars on the map indicate an ICN Point of Presence (POP). The number within the star indicates the Market Service Area (MSA) the POP is serving.

The State is divided into nine Regional Technology Centers (RTCs). The staff at these centers provide technical services, including maintaining the ICN POPs and the circuits connecting constituent facilities.

ICN POPs and distribution sites are located at state facilities, private businesses, county government facilities, regional offices of education and on university campuses.
