


for ROV Pilot and ROV Tender in Cook, Lake and Will Counties and for a new floating classification for diver, wet tender, tender, Remotely Operated Underwater Vehicles Pilot and Remotely Operated Underwater Vehicles Tender in the remaining counties, Exhibit A.

The parties and their respective representatives must be prepared to proceed at the hearing. The parties must present all information, documents, records or witnesses necessary to substantiate their position(s) at the hearing.

Pursuant to 56 Illinois Administrative Code 120.640, the Administrative Law Judge shall render a decision and issue an order on the objections pursuant to 820 ILCS 130/4 and 9, 56 Illinois Administrative Code 120.100 – 120.670. The decision will be the decision for and of the Director of Labor. A certified copy of the final administrative decision shall be filed with the Secretary of State, and a copy served personal service or certified/registered mail on all parties to the proceeding.

The proceedings under this hearing are subject to judicial review in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101 - 3-113. The Director of Labor's determination on the objections is final and binding unless a party to this proceeding applies for and obtains judicial review of the final administrative decision in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Review Law, 735 ILCS 5/3-101-113.

Re: Request for a hearing to establish a new Prevailing Wage classifications
for Operating Engineer – Floating

Dear Mr. Costigan:

I represent Allen Bingham, a member of the International Union of Operating Engineers, Local 150, AFL-CIO ("Local 150"), and Local 150. The purpose of this correspondence is to submit written objections and a request for a hearing pursuant to Sections 4 and 9 of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/4, 9). Local 150 proposes a new classifications for Operating Engineers performing work that involves remotely operated underwater vehicles (ROV), diving, and other activities on construction projects. The proposed classifications include:

- A new Class 6 Floating classification for ROV Pilot and ROV Tender on work performed in Cook, Lake and Will Counties
- A new Floating classification for Diver, Wet Tender, Tender, ROV Pilot and ROV Tender in Boone, Carroll, DuPage, DeKalb, Grundy, Jo Daviess, Kane, Kankakee, Kendall, LaSalle, Lee, Livingston, Mercer, McHenry, Ogle, Rock Island, Stephenson, Whiteside, and Winnebago counties

Local 150 members perform the work listed above and are therefore affected by the absence of such classifications.

EXHIBIT A

The work performed by a Diver, Wet Tender, Tender, ROV Pilot or ROV Tender is construction work as defined in sections 2 and 3 of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act because these workers are directly employed by contractors or subcontractors on a public works job site and/or in anticipation of construction (820 ILCS 130/2, 3). Further, there is no existing prevailing wage rates for these classifications in the counties described above.

IUOE Local 150 proposes the following be added to the Operating Engineer Floating classifications in Cook, Lake and Will counties:

Operating Engineer Class 6 – FLT	Wage Rate	Fringe Benefits
ROV Pilot, ROV Tender	\$35.00	H&W: \$16.60 Pension: \$11.05 Vacation: \$1.90 Training: \$1.25

In addition, IUOE Local 150 proposes the following new floating classification be added to the Operating Engineer classifications in Boone, Carroll, DuPage, DeKalb, Grundy, Jo Daviess, Kane, Kankakee, Kendall, LaSalle, Lee, Livingston, Mercer, McHenry, Ogle, Rock Island, Stephenson, Whiteside, and Winnebago counties:

Operating Engineer – FLT	Wage Rate	Fringe Benefits
Diver, Wet Tender, Tender, ROV Pilot, ROV Tender	\$35.00	H&W: \$16.60 Pension: \$11.05 Vacation: \$1.90 Training: \$1.25

On behalf of Mr. Bingham, Local 150 and the Local 150 membership, in accordance with Section 4 and 9 of the IPWA (820 ILCS 130/4, 9), I am requesting an investigatory hearing to establish new Prevailing Wage rates for Operating Engineer – Floating.
