Welcome and Acknowledgements

Chief Jay Reardon introduced Chief Jeff Macko, the new MABAS President.

Chairman Chamness acknowledged the upcoming retirement of Deputy Director Mike Snyders, Illinois State Police.

Special Presentations

Times Square Attempted Bombing – Aaron Kustermann, Chief of Intelligence, Illinois State Police.

Response Technology Solutions RFP and Alternate Care Site(s) – how they correlate with mass care and mass fatality – Mr. Karl Schmitt, Illinois Department of Public Health.

Chairman Chamness requested that the Bio-Terrorism Committee form a subcommittee to review this issue and advise what organizations should be represented on the subcommittee. The subcommittee will be tasked to frame the issue, what needs to be accomplished, and recommendations on how to accomplish these issues.

ITTF Issues

Credentialing Update – to date, 150 Tier 1 Cards have been issued. Recently, a document from NEMA that pertains to NIMS and Credentialing Standards has been received and reviewed, and we are in compliance with the document. It has been determined to change the strategy of issuing cards to all members of a special response teams. At the July Committee Chairs Meeting, a 4-5 point strategy will be presented and a motion to adopt will be presented that only team leaders will be issued a Tier 1 card; and the Team Leaders will vouch for their team members who have been issued Tier II cards.

Science and Technology Committee Update - Co-Chair Diane Hoots is seeking additional committee members. A committee meeting will be scheduled before the next ITTF meeting.

Short-term Strategies will be sent to the Committee Chairs prior to the July 28th meeting.

Cyber Project - The Public Information and Science and Technology Subcommittees have been working on a Cyber Safety Project. A BETA test site is available on the Ready Illinois website.
