

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING {PRIVATE }
BETWEEN THE
ILLINOIS EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY
AND THE
ILLINOIS LAW ENFORCEMENT ALARM SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency, hereinafter referred to as IEMA, and the Illinois Law Enforcement Alarm System, hereinafter referred to as ILEAS, jointly recognize the critical importance of assisting the Country of Japan in its response efforts in the wake of the March 11, 2011 earthquake and tsunami; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Notice of Grant Agreement between IEMA and ILEAS, effective October 10, 2007, ILEAS purchased Polimatrix Model PM1703M0-1 personal radiation detectors (PRDs) using Department of Homeland Security preparedness funds; and

WHEREAS, ILEAS holds legal title to the PRDs purchased pursuant to the Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, IEMA and ILEAS agree that a certain quantity of PRDs should be donated to Japan for their use in disaster response; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to an express written communication, the Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency, does not object to the donation of PRDs to the response efforts in Japan; and

IEMA and ILEAS hereby enter into and execute this Memorandum of Understanding, hereinafter referred to as "MOU," and hereby agree as follows:

A. AGREEMENT

ILEAS hereby authorizes the transfer of possession and control of 2,000 PRDs to IEMA for purposes contained herein pursuant to the terms and conditions below.

B. AUTHORITY

This MOU is entered into pursuant to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/1, *et seq.*, and is subject to all applicable Illinois and Federal statutes, and related regulatory requirements. All terminology in this Agreement shall be interpreted consistently with the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act and rules promulgated pursuant thereto.

C. OBJECTIVE

This agreement is for transfer of possession and control of 2,000 PRDs from ILEAS to IEMA. IEMA will donate the detectors to the Country of Japan to assist that nation with its response to its nuclear power plant crisis.

C. TERMS

ILEAS stores the PRDs at their facility in Urbana, Illinois. IEMA agrees to collect and retrieve the PRDs in a manner and time agreed upon with ILEAS.

D. AMENDMENTS AND TERMINATION

This MOU is not subject to amendment or termination unless expressly agreed upon, in writing, by both parties.

E. COSTS

There will be no guarantee of reimbursement or replacement to ILEAS for their transfer of possession and control to IEMA of the PRDs. However, IEMA recognizes the loss of these ILEAS assets and will use its best efforts to assist ILEAS in obtaining other forms of compensation if at all possible.


