I. Call to Order.

A meeting of Human Rights Commission Panel A was called to order on June 23, 2009 at 10:30 a.m. by Panel Chair Baricevic.

Pursuant to the Illinois Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/1 et seq., it was determined that:

1) A quorum of the public body was present at the meeting without the physical presence of Commissioner Baricevic.

2) Prior to the meeting, Commissioner Baricevic gave notice (and good cause as defined by the Illinois Open Meetings Act) to the General Counsel and Secretary of the Public Body, Harriet Parker, that she would be unable to be physically present for the June 23, 2009 meeting. The Commission voted to allow Commissioner Baricevic to participate in the meeting via telephone. Motion made by Commissioner Simoncini, seconded by Commissioner Enriquez. Motion carried 2-0.
