A meeting of the Illinois Human Rights Commission Panel B was called to order on Wednesday, November 19, 2014 at 11:00 a.m. by Panel Chair David Chang.

Commissioner David Chang moved to allow Commissioner Brad Cole to attend the November 19, 2014, Panel B meeting via video conference; motion seconded by Commissioner Cantone and abstained by Commissioner Cole. Motion carried.

III. Contested Matter

A. Casey Borek v. Sudler Property Management

Charge No.: 2011CN2867

ALS No. 13-0010

Panel B declined review of the Recommended Order and Decision, thereby making the Recommended Order and Decision dated June 7, 2013 the final Order and Decision of the Commission. Motion made by Commissioner Cantone; seconded by Commissioner Cole. Motion carried 3-0.

IV. Requests for Review

A. Margaret Fitzpatrick v. St. Anthony Hospital

Charge No.: 2011CF1906

ALS No.: 12-0109

Panel B sustained the dismissal of Counts B and C of the charge in the above-referenced matter for Lack of Substantial Evidence and vacated the dismissal of Count E of the charge based on a finding of substantial evidence and remanded Count F back to the Department of Human Rights for further investigation. Motion made by Commissioner Cole; seconded by Commissioner Cantone. Motion carried 3-0.

B. Warda Jubeh v. Levy Premium Food Services d/b/a Levy's Restaurants at Wrigley Field

Charge No.: 2011CA1144

ALS No.: 12-0106

Panel B sustained the dismissal of the charge in the above-referenced matter for Lack of Substantial Evidence. Motion made by Commissioner Cole; seconded by Commissioner Cantone. Motion carried 3-0.

C. Timothy L. Storm v. Illinois State Police

ALS No.: 12-0107

Panel B sustained the dismissal of the charge in the above-referenced matter pursuant to 775 ILCS 5/7A-102(G)(2) where Storm previously filed a complaint in the Circuit Court of Sangamon County. Motion made by Commissioner Cole; seconded by Commissioner Cantone. Motion carried 3-0.
