LINDSAY ANDERSON *Introductory speaker*

As Chair of the Illinois Board of Higher Education, Lindsay Anderson oversees a 16-member board which administers state and federal grants and approves academic programs for the state's colleges. An attorney at McGuireWoods, Ms. Anderson previously served as a senior advisor and legislative director to Illinois Governor Pat Quinn.

TODD ARMSTRONG *Presenter*

Master Sergeant R. Todd Armstrong is a 14 year veteran of the Illinois State Police (ISP). He currently serves as Section Chief of the Commercial Vehicle Section. He also teaches nationally for the Commercial Vehicle Safety Alliance's inspection program along with many in-state classes for local/county officers and ISP Cadets.

KEN BALLOM *2014 Steering Committee*

Associate Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs and Dean of Students at the University of Illinois, Ken Ballom has over 23 years of experience in student affairs and leadership. He directs several student affairs units including the Office of the Dean of Students; Career Center; Counseling Center; Office of Minority Student Affairs; and Student Conflict Resolution.

CYNTHIA CRONIN CAHILL *2014 Steering Committee*

Illinois Liquor Control Commissioner Cynthia Cronin Cahill is a 1980 graduate of the University of Notre Dame and is a practicing CPA in her own accounting business. She is past Treasurer of the City of Elmhurst and Alumni Board Member of the University of Notre Dame. Ms. Cahill is married and the mother of 5 children, ages 14-22 years.

DAVID CHAMBERS *Presenter*

Deputy Police Chief David A. Chambers began his law enforcement career in Charleston as a patrolman in 1990. As President of Prairie Management Institute, he provides a variety of consulting services for businesses and organizations, including BASSET instruction and Drug Free Workplace training. He also serves as an adjunct professor at Lake Land Community College.

JIM CLARK *Presenter*

In 2012, Lt. Jim Clark assumed the command of the South District of the City of Champaign, which encompasses the University of Illinois campus. Prior to his hiring by the Champaign Police Department in 1995, Lt. Clark worked at the Douglas County Sheriff's Office for three years and the Tuscola Police Department as a patrol officer and DARE officer for six years.

DOUG CULBERT *2014 Steering Committee*

Doug Culbert, PhD, is a clinical psychologist and Associate Director of the University of Chicago Student Counseling Service, where he oversees all substance-abuse services. In 1990, Dr. Culbert cofounded the first substance abuse prevention program at the U. of C. with funding from a US Department of Education grant. He has an active interest in young adult substance abuse issues and maintains a private practice in the Chicago area.

LISA CURRIE *2014 Steering Committee*

Lisa Currie joined Northwestern University in 2009 as Director of Health Promotion and Wellness. She is in her 18th year working as a college health educator, having previously served in this role at Wesleyan University (CT) and the University of Scranton (PA). ASHLEY DYE *Presenter*

Ashley Dye is Assistant Dean of Students at the University of Illinois. She also serves as Director of Fraternity & Sorority Affairs at the school.

SHAD EDWARDS *Presenter*

A sworn officer with the Illinois State Police for over 24 years, Master Sergeant Shad Edwards is the Dayshift Commander for Illinois State Police District 10 where he organizes special details related to traffic safety and fatality reductions. When he isn't at work, you would most likely find him with his two children or training for upcoming marathons and ultra-marathons.

BRIAN FARBER *Presenter*

Associate Dean of Students Brian Farber serves as Director of the Office for Student Conflict Resolution at the University of Illinois, where he is responsible for adjudicating Student Code violations, responding to bias motivated incidents, and assisting students in resolving complaints. He also works with the campus behavioral intervention and threat assessment teams, interpersonal violence response, and admissions review committees.

WILLIAM FEITHEN *2014 Steering Committee*

DeKalb Chief of Police Bill Feithen has over 30 years in law enforcement. A graduate of the FBI National Academy, with a M.P.A, the Chief has held many leadership roles in numerous organizations. His professional service includes experience as a juvenile officer and in investigations, patrol, community and media relations, alcohol enforcement/prevention grants, budgeting, and supervision.

A government and communications professional for over 25 years, Illinois Liquor Control Commission Education Manager Ted Penesis oversees the State of Illinois' tobacco enforcement operation, alcohol server training program, and underage drinking awareness efforts.
