BILL GENTES

Lake County Health Department

Bill also recently was given the CADACA National Advocate of the Year for his work with federal and state officials.

Southern Illinois University

Michelle McLernon has served as a Wellness Coordinator at the SIU Wellness and Health Promotion Services office for 14 years, providing education and skills-based training to college students on various health topics, including alcohol and substance use. Michelle has diverse experience in the field of substance use, including serving as a prevention specialist to seasonal migrant workers, conducting research on perinatal addiction, and coordinating prevention and intervention strategies on a college campus. MARY RUSSELL
