The City of Edwardsville with support of the State of Illinois and Chestnut Health Systems are presenting free B.A.S.S.E.T Training

The Beverage Alcohol Sellers and Servers Education and Training (BASSET) program is the State of Illinois' seller/server training program. Under the licensing and regulatory support of the Illinois Liquor Control Commission (ILCC), the BASSET Program is designed to encourage sellers/servers of alcoholic beverages to serve responsibly and stay within the law. The BASSET license will be **required** by IL State law for all alcohol servers and those who check ID's for on-premises alcohol consumption businesses. The new certification law takes effect **July 1, 2016**.

The goals and objectives of the BASSET Program are:

Train and educate sellers and servers to engage in responsible alcohol service;

Spot signs of intoxication and utilize various intervention techniques;

Prevent DUIs and alcohol-related fatalities;

Stop underage sales and underage drinking;

Educate owners, managers and staff on dram shop insurance, state laws, civil liabilities and local ordinances regarding alcohol service.

We would like to invite business owners, supervisors, bouncers, servers, and sellers of alcoholic beverages to attend this free training. Attendees will receive a certificate of attendance. Participants who pass the BASSET test, provided at the training, will later receive a BASSET License from the Illinois Liquor Control Commission. A list of attendee's full names from each business is required for the presentation of the certificate and license, prior to the trainings. Two training dates are available.
