**DECISION AND ORDER OF THE ILLINOIS LABOR RELATIONS BOARD
STATE PANEL**

On December 20, 2011, Executive Director John F. Brosnan dismissed the unfair labor practice charge filed by Dottie Atterberry (Charging Party) in the above-captioned case. The Charging Party alleged that the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees Council 31 (Respondent) engaged in unfair labor practices within the meaning of Section 10(b) of the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act, 5 ILCS 315/10(b) (2010), when Respondent failed to pursue Charging Party's grievance in which she claimed that, based on prior grievance settlements, she was entitled to a salary step increase.

The Charging Party filed a timely appeal of the Executive Director's Dismissal pursuant to Section 1200.135(a) of the Board's Rules and Regulations, 80 Ill. Admin. Code §1200.135(a). The Respondent filed no response. After reviewing the record and appeal, we uphold the Executive Director's Dismissal.


