**DECISION AND ORDER OF THE ILLINOIS LABOR RELATIONS BOARD
STATE PANEL**

On September 26, 2012, Administrative Law Judge Elaine Tarver issued a Recommended Decision and Order in the above-captioned case, recommending that the Illinois Labor Relations Board, State Panel, dismiss the petition filed by the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, District 8 (Petitioner). The Petitioner sought to represent employees of the State of Illinois, Department of Central Management Services (Employer), in the title of Public Service Administrator, Option 6, working as local office administrators in the Department of Human Services. As noted by the Administrative Law Judge, a different union sought to represent these employees in two petitions recently rejected by the Board in State of Illinois (Dep't of Cent. Mgmt. Serv. (Dep't of Healthcare & Family Servs.), Case No. S-UC-09-182, 28 PERI 75 (IL LRB-SP 2011), and State of Illinois, Dep't of Cent. Mgmt. Serv., Case No. S-UC-10-014, 26 PERI 116 (IL LRB-SP 2010).

The Petitioner filed timely exceptions to the Recommended Decision and Order pursuant to Section 1200.135 of the Board's Rules and Regulations, 80 Ill. Admin. Code, Parts 1200 through 1240, and subsequently amended those exceptions. The Employer has not filed a response. After reviewing the record, brief, and amended exceptions, we adopt the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Decision and Order, and dismiss the petition for the reasons she provided.¹
