**Minutes of the State Panel Meeting  
Held on June 3, 2014**

**I. OPENING OF MEETING 1:00 P.M.—One Natural Resources Way, Springfield, Illinois**

**II. PRESENT**

John Hartnett, Chairman of the Board; Paul Besson, Member of the Board; James Brennwald, Member of Board; Albert Washington, Member of the Board; Melissa Mlynski, Executive Director; Jerald S. Post, General Counsel; Sarah Kerley, Deputy General Counsel, and staff members.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING HELD May 13, 2014**

Chairman Hartnett called for approval of the minutes of the May 13, 2014 meeting. Member Brennwald noted an error in the minutes. Member Washington moved to approve the minutes with the correction. Member Besson seconded. The Board passed the motion unanimously, by a voice vote.

**IV. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS**

Chairman Hartnett asked Executive Director Mlynski to present the State Panel administrative actions report for the period of time from May 1 through May 31, 2014. She presented the report and summarized its highlights. The Board examined the report and discussed it.

**V. BOARD ACTIONS**

**1. Case Nos. S-CA-12-057 and S-RC-10-133  
International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 700/ County of McHenry and McHenry County Health Department**

Chairman Hartnett called the case, noting that no party filed exceptions to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Tarver's Recommended Decision and Order (RDO), and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

**2. Case No. S-RD-14-003  
Theresa Kyriazes/ Park Ridge Park District/ Service Employees International Union, Local 73**

Chairman Hartnett called the case, noting that no party filed exceptions to ALJ Kehoe's RDO, and asked whether the Board wished to review the decision on its own motion. The Board declined to do so.

**3. Case No. S-CB-14-012  
John Blomenkamp/ Policemen's Benevolent and Protective Association**

Chairman Hartnett asked General Counsel Post to call the case. General Counsel Post called the case then asked Deputy General Counsel Kerley to present the issues of the case. Deputy General Counsel Kerley stated that an Executive Director dismissal issued on a charge filed by the Charging Party alleging the Respondent violated Section 10(b) of the Act. She then presented and discussed Charging Party's appeal. After her presentation, Deputy General Counsel Kerley recommended that the Board accept the dismissal. After discussion, Member Washington moved to accept the dismissal. Member Besson seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

**4. Case No. S-CB-14-014  
Steven Burrows/ Policemen's Benevolent and Protective Association**

Chairman Hartnett asked General Counsel Post to call the case. General Counsel Post called the case then asked Deputy General Counsel Kerley to present the issues of the case. Deputy General Counsel Kerley stated that an Executive Director dismissal issued on a charge filed by the Charging Party alleging the Respondent violated Section 10(b) of the Act. She then presented and discussed Charging Party's appeal. After her presentation, Deputy General Counsel Kerley recommended that the Board accept the dismissal. After discussion, Member Besson moved to accept the dismissal. Member Washington seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

**5. Case Nos. S-CB-14-017 and S-CB-13-041  
Mary Levy/ Service Employees International Union, Local 73**

Chairman Hartnett asked General Counsel Post to call and present the case. General Counsel Post stated that the Executive Director dismissed the charge filed by the Charging Party, alleging that the Respondent violated Section 10(b) of the Act. General Counsel Post, with the aid of Associate General Counsel Hamburg-Gal's memo, presented and discussed the Charging Party's appeal and Respondent's response. After discussion, General Counsel Post recommended that the Board affirm the dismissal. Member Brennwald made a motion to affirm the dismissal with a modification. Member Besson seconded the motion, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.

**VI. EXECUTIVE SESSION**

After a short discussion regarding whether there was a need for executive session, the Board concluded it was unnecessary.

**VII. ADJOURNMENT**

Chairman Hartnett called for a motion to adjourn. Member Washington made a motion to adjourn the meeting, and the Board passed it unanimously, by a voice vote.
