The Office of Executive Inspector General for the Agencies of the Illinois Governor (OEIG) ensures accountability in State government by functioning as an independent, non-partisan State agency with responsibility, pursuant to State law, to investigate allegations of fraud, waste, abuse, and misconduct. The OEIG is looking to fill an unpaid legal internship/externship position for the Fall 2016 term. The incumbent will work out of the OEIG's Chicago office.

The OEIG Internship/Externship Program provides students with the opportunity to apply their education and classroom theory to actual work situations in an investigative and legal environment.

Interns/externs are provided the opportunity to acquire hands-on, relevant experience on how OEIG investigations are conducted. Additionally, interns/externs will have the opportunity to assist staff by conducting legal research, drafting memoranda on matters related to the functions and policies of the office and may assist in reviewing cases and writing reports.

Legal interns must be a current second or third year student (or its equivalent if a part-time student) enrolled in an accredited law school.
