The Office of Executive Inspector General for the Agencies of the Illinois Governor (OEIG) ensures accountability in State government by functioning as an independent, non-partisan State agency with responsibility, pursuant to State law, to investigate allegations of fraud, waste, abuse, and misconduct. The OEIG is looking to fill an unpaid investigative intern position in the Chicago office and an unpaid investigative intern position in the Springfield office for the Spring 2017 term.

The OEIG Internship Program provides students with the opportunity to apply their education and classroom theory to actual work situations in an investigative and legal environment.

Interns are provided the opportunity to acquire hands-on, relevant experience on how OEIG investigations are conducted. Additionally, interns will have the opportunity to conduct research and analysis, and to solicit requisite materials and evidence within very limited authority.

Investigative interns must be a current second or third year student (or its equivalent if a part-time student) enrolled in an accredited school.

Failure to submit the required documents may result in the application not being considered.
