1. Utility forecasts – discussed the forecasts submitted by ComEd and Ameren. Also discussed the possibility of opportunity for stakeholder feedback in updated utility forecasts in March following ICC approval of the IPA plan.
2. Draft IPA procurement plan – discussed the mechanics of a second procurement to address load forecast uncertainties

3. Curtailed long-term renewable energy contracts – discussed concerns associated with future curtailments of long term contracts.
4. IPA strawman – discussed IPA's strawman proposal on prioritization of use of funds to meet the RPS standard under potential legislation.
5. Future Illinois legislation to address RPS implementation issues – discussed SB 103 and potential for passing legislation in the 2013 Veto Session.



1. Respondents indicated that ComEd and Ameren are fully responsible for load forecasts and that IPA doesn't modify them.
2. Respondents explained their rationale for the potential need for a second procurement as a function of load uncertainty due to potential reverse load migration.
3. Respondents indicated an understanding of the Initiator's concern regarding how curtailments had been effected for the current plan year, but did not offer their own opinion on the possible solution provided by the Initiator.
4. Respondents provided an explanation of the strawman proposal.
5. Respondents appreciated the status update and requested that they be apprised of further developments.
