This is to acknowledge receipt of the type A modification request to the application for permit under the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act. Your modification request, received on June 9, 2010, has been entered into the case file.

The initial fee for the modification is \$2,000, and the readjusted balance of the original project fee is \$10,983.95. The total balance of your fee has been determined to be **\$12,983.95** and **payment should be made to the Illinois Department of Public Health within thirty (30) days of your receipt of this notice.**

It is possible that a public hearing may be requested on your project pursuant to the provisions of Part 1130.910. If so, you will be contacted regarding the time and place for the public hearing.

A review of your project will be conducted by the State Agency and a report of findings will be submitted to the State Board. You will receive a copy of the report and have an opportunity to appear before the State Board to answer any questions that members may have.

NOTICE OF REVIEW AND OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC HEARING AND WRITTEN COMMENT

In accordance with the requirements of the Illinois Health Facilities Planning Act, notice is given of receipt of an application for permit modification regarding a proposed project (Project 10-005), Smith Crossing, Orland Park. The applicants propose to increase the total cost of the original permit application.

- 1) The applicants are proposing to increase the total estimated project cost from \$240,000 to \$5,846,587.
- 2) The applicants propose to extend the project completion date 6 months, from December 31, 2010, to June 30, 2011.
