

The Family Health Partnership Clinic, located in Woodstock, Illinois is a key outpatient service provider for McHenry County's uninsured and underinsured. When our clinic was opened in 1996, there were an estimated 15,000 uninsured residents in the county. Recent census data show that there are now well over 40,000 people living in McHenry County with no health insurance. 
