
Dear Mr. Galassie:

I am a Group Facility Administrator for DaVita. As such, I am familiar with traffic issues in HSA 11, the planning area where the proposed Shiloh Dialysis will be located. I am writing to provide additional information to the Health Facilities and Services Review Board ("Board") regarding the actual travel time from Shiloh to Granite City Dialysis.

According to MapQuest calculations, the time from the proposed Shiloh Dialysis to Granite City Dialysis is approximately 30 minute. On December 20, 2011, I was tasked with driving from the site of the proposed Shiloh Dialysis to Granite City Dialysis to determine the accuracy of MapQuest travel time and whether Granite City Dialysis is located within the 30-minute geographic service area of Shiloh Dialysis. I drove the shortest and fastest routes as determined by MapQuest. Driving the "shortest" route, it took 40 minutes in light traffic to drive from the proposed site of Shiloh Dialysis to Granite City Dialysis. Driving the "fastest" route, it took 31 minutes in normal traffic to drive from Granite City Dialysis to Shiloh Dialysis. Based on my experience, Granite City Dialysis lies just beyond Shiloh Dialysis' 30-minute travel radius.

I hope this information is helpful to the Board.
