On April 16, 2013 the Illinois Health Facilities and Services Review Board approved a permit renewal for the above-captioned projects. Therefore, the permits for these projects have been renewed until May 31, 2014.

Should the permit holder determine that it will be unable to complete the project by May 31, 2014;



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the permit holder may request another renewal of the permit. 77 IAC 1130.740 provides that the State Agency must be in receipt of a permit renewal request AT LEAST 45 DAYS PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE REQUIRED COMPLETION PERIOD.

The permit holder is reminded that permits for projects which are not completed within the required time frame shall expire for lack of due diligence, unless renewed by the State Board. The permit holder is also reminded of the other post-permit requirements contained in "Subpart G" of Part 1130. Adherence to these requirements is essential in maintaining a valid permit and is the sole responsibility of the permit holder.
