



I am addressing this document in support of the Good Samaritan at Pontiac CON. A few years ago, I was involved with Livingston Manor, the County Nursing Home. Our group was disappointed when Livingston County gave up its nursing home; however, we were fortunate that the nursing home itself did not close its doors. I do not believe the issues have changed only the ownership and operation of the Good Samaritan at Pontiac.

My Mother spent the last eleven years of her life as a resident of Livingston Manor. The care was superior, as well as the love of the staff.

The primary concern our group held was the lack of MEDICAID beds that would be available for the residents of Livingston County if Livingston Manor was taken over by another organization. The contract that Good Samaritan signed guarantees MEDICAID beds and would not limit the number of residents that were to be on MEDICAID.

Back then and I believe NOW there is a major need for this type of service to the County. We are all gaining in seniority, and I believe the "Baby-Boomers" will have issues IF facilities were taken off the market.

Back then and I believe NOW, IF the County would have constructed a new facility, it would have been close to 90% capacity within 18 months. I remember when the County Board was putting negative issues about Livingston Manor to the public, and the Manor had more than 70 residences for an extended period of time. But because of the uncertainty of the current facility, family members were/are somewhat reluctant to place their loved ones at that location with the possibility of being required to relocate them in the near future.

In the past, Livingston Manor was greatly appreciated because they had a place for citizens who had limited resources, and because of the contract, Good Samaritan at Pontiac will do the same. Like Livingston Manor, Good Samaritan at Pontiac needs to update and modernize their facility so that the facility will be energy efficient and more accommodating for the Staff and Residents. Along with constructing a new facility, it should be built in a location that would be advantageous to the health care of the residents.

I and all of my family members as well as many members of Livingston County will support the CON and the construction of a greatly needed modern facility. The Citizens deserve this!

Dear Members of the Board:

I am writing to request that you approve Good Samaritan's application to build a new facility, to replace the existing one, in Pontiac. I worked in this building, previously, as a Nursing Home Administrator and can tell you that a new facility is badly needed. The current building is becoming less attractive to prospective residents and families alike. This is primarily due to small resident room sizes (an IDPH waiver is given to the facility every year for this) and because there are community restrooms and showers in the existing facility (most residents, today, prefer the privacy and proximity of a private restroom).

Another important need, that can be fulfilled with a new facility, is a locked Memory Care Unit. Not only will this greatly decrease the risk of a resident elopement, it will alleviate issues that sometimes arise from residents with Alzheimer's Disease wandering into other residents' rooms uninvited.

A new facility would also be less expensive to operate. With recent State cuts in Medicaid and a high Medicaid case-mix, it is important to minimize operational costs. This can be achieved in a new facility because a modern heating/cooling system would be less expensive to operate than the current boiler system, which uses fuel oil as an energy source (costing over a quarter of a million dollars, each winter, just to heat the place!). There are also expensive physical plant issues, that will have to be addressed in the existing facility, such as the new, fully-sprinkled rule that is going into effect next year.

I urge you to approve Good Samaritan's application to replace the existing facility, with a new one, in Pontiac.
